#### WHO IS THE MESSIAH OF ISRAEL? 220 Scriptures

You know these are the days of the birth-pains of the Messiah, but do you know who He is? This little booklet contains <u>220 Scripture prophesies</u> about the Messiah <u>taken only from the Tanakh</u>, the Jewish Holy Scriptures. Read these; **for they clearly prove Yeshua is the true Messiah of Israel**!

Genesis 3:15 [the Messiah!] "And I will put enmity between you (Satan) and the woman (Eve), and between your seed and <u>her Seed</u>. He (<u>the Messiah from Eve's Seed</u>) <u>shall bruise your head</u>, and <u>you (Satan) shall bruise (Blood) His heal</u>."

Genesis 18:13, 14 And the LORD said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh, saying, 'Shall I really bear a child when I am old?' **Is anything too hard for the LORD?** At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and **Sarah shall have a son**." (also see Jeremiah 32:17, 27)

Isaiah 7:14 [the Messiah!] Therefore the LORD Himself shall give you <u>a sign</u>; Behold, <u>a virgin</u> shall conceive, and <u>bear a SON</u>, and shall call <u>His name Immanuel</u> (God with us). (See Genesis 3:15 and Psalm 132:11)

Isaiah 9:6, 7 [the Messiah!] For unto us <u>a Child is born</u>, unto us <u>a Son is given</u>. And the Government shall be upon His shoulder. And His Name shall be called Wonderful (Miracle), Counsellor, <u>the Mighty God</u>, <u>the Everlasting Father</u>, the Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His Government and Peace there shall be no end upon the Throne of David, and upon His Kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with Judgment and Justice from henceforth,

even forever. The zeal of <u>the LORD of hosts will perform this</u>.

Micah 5:2, 4 [the Messiah!]

But you, **Bethlehem Ephratah**, though you be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of you **He shall come forth to Me** <u>who is to be Ruler</u> <u>in Israel</u>; whose goings forth have been from of old, <u>from Everlasting</u>. And He shall stand and feed in the Strength of the LORD, in the **Majesty** of the name of the LORD His God; and **They shall Abide**. For now <u>**He shall be Great** to the ends of the earth</u>.

Genesis 1:26; Genesis 3:22; Genesis 11:7; Isaiah 6:8; Isaiah 48:16; "<u>Let 'Us' make Adam</u> in '<u>Our' image</u>, after '<u>Our' likeness</u>. And <u>let them have Dominion</u> over the fish of the sea, **over** the birds **of the** air, and over the cattle, and <u>over all the earth</u>, over every creeping thing ..." "Behold, Adam has become <u>like one of 'Us</u>', to know good and evil!" "Come, <u>let 'Us' go down</u> and <u>let 'Us</u>' confuse their language..." "Whom shall I send, and <u>who will go for 'Us</u>'?" "And now <u>the LORD GOD</u> and <u>His Spirit</u> have <u>sent Me!</u>"

#### Genesis 12:1-3

Now **the LORD had said to Abram**, "Get out of your country, from your family, and from your father's house, to a land that I will shew you. I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great. And you shall be a blessing. <u>I will bless those who bless you</u>, <u>and I will curse him who curses you</u>. And <u>in you</u> (Abram) all the families of the earth shall be blessed!"

Genesis 14:18-20 (see Psalm 110:1, 4) [the Preincarnate Messiah!] <u>And Melchi Zedek</u> (My King of Righteousness), King of Salem, brought forth <u>bread</u> and <u>wine</u>; and <u>He was Priest of God Most High</u>. And He blessed him, and said, <u>Blessed be Abram</u> of God Most High, **possessor of heaven and earth.** And blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand. And he (Abram) gave Him (Melchi Zedek) tithes of all.

Genesis 18:1, 2, 17, 18, 22 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]
Then the LORD appeared to him by the terebinth trees of Mamre ...
see, three men were standing near him ... And the LORD said,
"Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing...? Then the men turned away and went toward Sodom, but Abraham still stood before the LORD.
Genesis 19:1 Now the two messengers came to Sodom in the evening ...

Genesis 22:8, 10-14, 15-18 (spoken at Mt Moriah; the Temple Mount today) And Abraham said, My SON, God will provide Himself a Lamb for a burnt offering. So they went both of them together... And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. And the Angel of the LORD called to him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham, and he said, Here am I. And He said, Do not lay your hand upon the lad, neither do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, seeing that you have not withheld your son, your only son from Me. And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him <u>a ram caught in a</u> <u>thicket by his horns</u>. And Abraham went and <u>took the ram and offered him</u> up for a burnt offering <u>instead of his son</u>. And Abraham called the name of that place 'Jehovah Jireh'... And <u>the Angel of the LORD called to</u> <u>Abraham out of heaven the second time, and said, "By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD</u>, because you have done this thing, <u>and have not withheld</u> your son, your only son, that in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply your seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and your seed shall possess the gate of your enemies. And in your Seed (Messiah) <u>all the nations of the earth shall be blessed</u>, because you have obeyed My voice." [Yeshua, the Angel of the LORD!]

Genesis 32:24, 26-30 [Jacob wrestled with the Angel of LORD: Hosea 12:4] ...Jacob was left alone. And <u>a Man wrestled with him</u> until the breaking of the day. And He said, "Let Me go, for the day breaks." But he said, "I will not let You go unless You bless me!" So He said to him, "<u>What is your name</u>?" He said, "Jacob." And He said, "<u>Your name shall no longer be called Jacob</u>, **but Israel**; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed." Then Jacob asked, saying, "<u>Tell me Your name</u>, I pray." And He said, "<u>Why is it that you ask about My name</u>?" And He blessed him there. So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: "<u>for I have seen God face to face</u>, and my life is preserved." [**the Preincarnate Messiah!**]

Genesis 48:15, 16, 17, 19 And he (Jacob) blessed Joseph, and said, "God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac walked, <u>the God which fed me all my life long</u> to this day, <u>the Angel who has redeemed me from all evil</u>, <u>bless the lads</u>. Let my name be named upon them, and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth." Now when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand on the head of Ephraim, it displeased him; so he took hold of his father's hand to remove it from **Ephraim's head** to Manasseh's head. But his father refused and said, "I know, my son, I know. He also shall become a people, and he also shall be great; but <u>truly his younger brother shall be greater than he</u>, and <u>his descendants shall become a multitude of nations</u>."

Genesis 49:10 (It happened in days of Yeshua ... also see Numbers 24:17) <u>The Scepter shall not depart from Judah</u>, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, <u>until Shiloh come</u>; and <u>to Him shall be the gathering of the people</u>. [the Messiah!]

Genesis 49:24 But his (Joseph's) bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by <u>the Hands</u> of the Mighty God of Jacob; (from thence is **the Shepherd**, <u>the Stone</u> [Aven = Av + ben] <u>of Israel</u>.)

#### Exodus 3:2-6 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

And <u>the Angel of the LORD</u> appeared unto him (Moses) <u>in a flame of fire</u> out of the midst of a bush; and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, **God called to him** <u>out of the midst of</u> <u>the bush</u>, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here I am. And He said, Do not draw near this place; take your sandals off your feet, <u>for the place</u> <u>where you stand is holy ground</u>. Moreover He said, <u>I am God of your</u> <u>father</u>, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

Exodus 15:6 (also see Psalm 74:11, 12) Your Right Hand, O LORD, is become Glorious in Power; Your Right Hand, O LORD, <u>has dashed the enemy in pieces</u>.

Exodus 20:3-5 You shall have <u>no other gods</u> before Me!
You shall not make for yourself a carved image, any likeness of anything...
You shall not bow down to them nor serve them, for <u>I the LORD your God</u> am a Jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; (and Deuteronomy 5:9)

#### Exodus 23:20-23 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

See, <u>I send an Angel before you</u>, to guard you in the way, and <u>to bring you</u> to the place which I have prepared. Beware of Him, and obey His voice, do not rebel against Him; for <u>He will not forgive your rebellion</u>, because <u>My Name</u> is in Him! But if you indeed <u>obey His voice</u>, and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies, and

an adversary to your adversaries. For My Angel shall go before you ...

Leviticus 17:11 (also see Deuteronomy 32:43) For the life of the flesh is in <u>the blood</u>: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make Atonement for your souls; [Messiah's Blood!] for it is the Blood that makes Atonement for the soul!

Leviticus 19:2 Speak to all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say to them, <u>You shall be holy</u>, for I the LORD your God am Holy! Numbers 14:21 But truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with **the Glory of the LORD!** 

Numbers 21:8, 9 [Prophetic picture of the Crucified Messiah on the tree!] Then the LORD said to Moses, "<u>Make a fiery serpent</u>, and set it on a pole. And it shall come to pass that <u>every one who is bitten</u>, when he looks at it, <u>shall live</u>." So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole.

And so it was, that if a serpent had bitten anyone, <u>when he looked</u> at the bronze serpent, <u>he lived</u>! [i.e. Lord Yeshua crucified]

Numbers 23:19 (also see 1<sup>st</sup> Samuel 15:29)

<u>God is not a man that He should lie;</u> nor a son of man that He should repent. Has He said <u>and will He not do it</u>, or has He spoken <u>and will He not make it good</u>.

Numbers 24:17[the Coming Messiah!]I see Him, but not now; I behold Him, but not near.A Star shall comeout of Jacob, a Scepter rise out of Israel, and shall smite the brow of Moab...

Deuteronomy 4:34 Or did God ever try to go and take for Himself a nation from the midst of another nation, by trials, by signs, by wonders, by war, by <u>a Mighty Hand</u> and <u>an outstretched Arm</u>, and by great terrors, according to all that the LORD your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes?

Deuteronomy 5:15 And remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God brought you out from there by <u>a Mighty</u> <u>Hand</u> and by <u>an outstretched Arm</u>; therefore the LORD your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.

Deuteronomy 6:4, 5 Hear, O Israel: The LORD <u>our God's</u> (יהוה אחד)! (plural), the LORD is One (יהוה אחד)!

## And you shall love the LORD your God

with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your might.

Deuteronomy 18:15, 18, 19 **[the Messiah!]** The LORD your God <u>will raise up for you a **PROPHET**</u> from the midst of you, of your brothers, like unto me (Moses); <u>Him you shall hear</u>. I will raise up <u>a **Prophet** from among their brothers, like unto you (Moses), and I will put **My Words in His mouth**; and He shall speak to them **all that** <u>I command Him</u>. And it shall come to pass, that <u>whosoever will not listen</u> <u>to My Words</u> which He shall speak in My name, <u>I will require it of him</u>!</u>

# Deuteronomy 19:15 ... at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, the matter shall be established!

Deuteronomy 24:16

Fathers shall not be put to death for their children, nor shall children be put to death for their fathers. <u>A person shall be put to death **for his own sin!**</u>

Deuteronomy 27:26 "<u>Cursed</u> is the one who does not keep (all) the words of this Torah, to do them ... Then all the people shall say, '**Amen**!'"

Deuteronomy 29:3, 4 The great temptations which your eyes have seen, the signs, and <u>those great miracles</u>. Yet to this day **the LORD** <u>has not</u> <u>given you a heart to perceive</u>, and eyes to see, and ears to hear.

Deuteronomy 32:39-41, 43 (Also see Psalm 65:3; Psalm 79:9)

See now that **I**, **even I**, **am He**, and there is no God with Me. I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal; neither is there any that can deliver out of My hand. For I lift up My hand to Heaven, and say, **I live forever!** If I wet My glittering sword, and My hand takes hold on Judgment, I will render vengeance to My enemies, and will reward them that hate me. Rejoice, Oh you nations, with His people. for <u>He will avenge the blood</u> <u>of His servants</u>, and will render vengeance to His adversaries, and **He will provide** <u>Atonement (Blood) for His land and His people</u>.

Deuteronomy 33:2, 3 And he said: "The LORD came from Sinai, and dawned on them from Seir; He shone forth from Mount Paran, and He came with myriads of saints; [? from His right Hand came a fiery law for them ?]. Yes, He Loves the people; <u>all His saints are in **Your Hand**</u>; they sit down at Your feet; everyone receives **Your Words**.

#### Joshua 5:13-15 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood <u>a Man over against him with His sword</u> <u>drawn in His hand</u>. And Joshua went to Him, and said to Him, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?" He said, "No; but <u>as Commander of the Army</u> <u>of the LORD I have now come</u>. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, <u>and WORShiped</u>, and said to Him, "What does <u>my Lord</u> say to His servant?" And the Commander of the LORD's Army said to him, "Take the sandle off your foot; for the place where you stand is holy." Joshua did so. Judges 13:3, 18, 20, 22 **[the Preincarnate Messiah!]** (See Genesis 32:29) And <u>the Angel of the LORD</u> appeared to the woman, and said to her, Behold you are sterile and childless, but you shall conceive and bear a son. And <u>the Angel of the LORD</u> said to him, <u>Why do you ask Me what is</u> <u>My name, seeing that it is **Wonderful**</u>? For it came to pass, when the flame went up toward heaven from off the altar, that <u>the Angel of the LORD</u> ascended in the flame of the altar. And Manoah and his wife looked on it, and fell on their faces to the ground. ...<u>we have seen God</u>! (See Isaiah 9:6)

1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 16:17, 18 And confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, to Israel for **an Everlasting Covenant**, saying, "<u>To you I will give the land of Canaan</u> as the allotment of your inheritance," [This Truth in 12 places; 11 in Genesis: 12:7; 15:18; 17:8; 24:7; 26:3; 28:4; 28:13; 35:12; 48:4; 48:21; 50:24; Ex 6:4)

1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 17:10-15 (also in 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 7:5, 12-16) **[the Messiah!]** Furthermore, I tell you (David) that the LORD will build you a house. And it shall come to pass, when your days for fulfilled and you must go to be with your fathers, that I will raise up **your Seed** after you, which shall be from your sons; and <u>I will establish His Kingdom</u>. He shall build Me a House, and <u>I will establish His Throne forever</u>. I will be His Father, and <u>He shall be My Son</u>: and I will not take My Mercy away from Him, as I took it from him that was before you.

But <u>I will establish Him in My House and in My Kingdom forever</u>; and His Throne shall be established forevermore! According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so did Nathan speak to king David. [the Messiah from king David's family!]

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 5:13, 14

It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, <u>to make one</u> <u>sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD</u>; and when they lifted up their voice <u>with the silver trumpets</u>, <u>cymbals and instruments of music</u>, praised the LORD, saying, "For He is Good; <u>for His Mercy endures forever</u>!", that then **the House was filled with a Cloud**, even the House of the LORD; So that <u>the priests could not stand to minister</u> by reason of **the Cloud**! for <u>the Glory of the LORD</u> filled the House of God.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 7:1-3

When Solomon had finished praying, fire came down from Heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; <u>and the Glory of the LORD</u> <u>filled the Temple</u>. And the priests could not enter the House of the LORD, **because the Glory of the LORD had** <u>filled the LORD's House</u>!

When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the Glory of the LORD on the Temple, they bowed their faces to the ground on the pavement, and worshiped and praised the LORD, saying: **"For He is Good; for His Mercy endures forever!"** 

Second Chronicles 20:20 (also see Amos 3:7 and Isaiah 44:26) Hear me, O Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem. **Believe in the LORD your God**, <u>so you shall be established</u>; <u>believe in His prophets</u>, and you shall prosper.

Job 19:26 (also see Psalm 49:15 and John 6:39, 40, 44, 54) And after my skin is destroyed, <u>I know that in my flesh **I shall see God**;</u>

Psalm 2:2-4, 6, 7, 12 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, <u>against the LORD</u>, and against <u>His Anointed</u>, saying "Let us break their bonds in pieces and cast away their cords from us." He who sits in the heavens shall laught; The LORD shall hold them in derision.

Yet I have set **My King** <u>upon **My holy hill of Zion**</u>. (Joel 3:17) I will declare the decree, the LORD has said unto me, "<u>You are My Son</u>; <u>this day I have begotten You</u>." Kiss the Son, <u>lest He be angry,</u> <u>and you perish from the way</u>, when His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they <u>that put their trust in Him (in the Son</u>). [the Messiah!]

Psalm :84-6 (Genesis 1:26-28)

What is man, that You are mindful of him? And the son of Adam, that You visit him? For You have made him a little lower than Elohim, and have crowned him with glory and honor. You have made him <u>to have dominion</u> over the works of Your hands; You have put <u>all things under his feet</u> ...

Psalm 14:3 There is none who does good, no, not one. (also Psalm 53:1, 3)

Psalm 14:7 Oh that <u>the Salvation (ישועה) of Israel</u> were come out of Zion! When the LORD brings back the captivity of His people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad. (also see Psalm 53:6 and Isaiah 59:20)

Psalm 15:1, 2, 3, 4 **LORD**, <u>who shall abide in Your Tent</u>? Who shall dwell in Your holy Mountain? He that walks uprightly, and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in his heart; He who does not backbite with his tongue, nor does evil to his neighbor, nor a reproach against his friend; in whose eyes a vile person is despised, but he honors those who fear the LORD ... he who does not put out his money at usury, nor does he take a bride against the innocent. He who does those things shall never be moved. Psalm 22:1-31 (also see Psalm 31:5; Psalm 35:15-24; Psalm 69:7-34)

#### My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?

Why are You so far from helping Me, and from the words of My groaning? O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear Me; and in the night season, and am not silent. But **You are Holy**, enthroned in the praises of Israel. Our fathers trusted in You, they trusted and You did deliver them. They cried to You, and were delivered. They trusted in You, and were not ashamed. But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised by the people. All those who see Me ridicule Me! They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, 'He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him.' But You are He that took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust when I was on My mother's breasts. I was cast upon You from birth. You have been My God from My mother's womb. Be not far from Me, for trouble is near; for there is none to help. Many bulls have surrounded Me; strong bulls of Bashan have encircled Me. They gape at Me with their mouths, like a raging and roaring lion. I am poured out like water, and all My bones are out of joint. My heart is like wax; it is melted within Me. My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and My tongue clings to My jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death. For dogs have surrounded Me; the assembly of the wicked have enclosed Me.

## 22:16 They pierced My hands and My feet!

I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. They divide My garments among them, and cast lots for My clothing. But be not far from Me, O LORD! O My Strength, hasten to help Me. Deliver Me from the sword; My precious life from the power of the dog. Save Me from the lion's mouth: and from the horns of the wild oxen. You have answered Me. I will declare Your name to My brethren; in the midst of the assembly I will praise You. You that fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him; and fear Him, all you offspring of Israel. For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; nor has He hid His face from Him. But when He cried to Him, He heard. My praise shall be to You in the Great Congregation; I will pay My vows before those that fear Him. The poor shall eat and be satisfied; those that seek Him shall praise the LORD. Your heart shall live forever! All the ends of the world shall remember and turn to the LORD, and all the families of the nations shall worship before You. For the Kingdom is the LORD'S, and He Rules over the nations. All the prosperous of the earth shall eat and worship. All those who go down to the dust shall bow before Him, even he who can not keep himself alive. A posterity shall serve Him; it shall be counted to the LORD to the next generation. They shall come and declare His righteousness to a people that shall be born, that He has done this. [Crucified Messiah!]

Psalm 16:10 ... You will not let <u>Your Holy One see decay</u>.
Psalm 16:11 You will show me <u>the path of Life</u>. In Your Presence <u>is fulness of Joy</u>. At Your right Hand <u>are pleasures forevermore</u>!

Psalm 24:3-6

Who shall ascend the hill of the LORD or who shall stand

in His holy place? He who has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, nor sworn deceitfully. He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his Salvation. This is Jacob, the generation of them that seek Him, <u>that seek Your face</u>.

Psalm 24:7-10 [the Risen Messiah is the King of Glory!] Lift up your heads, O you gates; and be lifted up, you Everlasting doors; and <u>the King of Glory</u> shall come in. Who is this King of Glory? The LORD Strong and Mighty, the LORD Mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates; even lift them up, you everlasting doors; and the KING of GLORY shall come in. <u>Who is this KING of GLORY</u>? The LORD of hosts, He is the King of Glory!

#### Psalm 31:5 "Into Your hand I commit My Spirit ..."

Psalm 34:19, 20 Many are the afflictions of the righteous, <u>but the LORD delivers Him</u> <u>out of them all</u>. <u>He keeps all His bones</u>, not one of them is broken.

Psalm 40:7, 8, 10 [the Messiah!] Then said I, "Behold, <u>I Come</u>, <u>in the scroll of the Book</u> it is written of Me. I delight to do Your will, O My God. And <u>Your Torah is within My heart</u>. I have declared <u>Your Faithfulness and Your Salvation</u>. I have not hidden <u>Your Lovingkindness and Your Truth</u> from the great assembly...

Psalm 41:7, 9 All that hate Me whisper together against Me; against Me do they devise My hurt. Yes, <u>My own familiar friend</u>, in whom I trusted, who did eat of My bread, <u>has lifted up his heel against Me</u>.

Psalm 44:3 For they did not gain possession of the land by their own sword, nor did their own arm save them. But it was <u>Your Right Hand</u>, <u>Your Arm</u>, and the light of Your Countenance, because You favored them.

Psalm 45:2-7, 16[the Messiah!]You are fairer than the children of men. Grace is poured onto Your lips.

Therefore God has blessed You forever. Gird Your sword upon Your thigh, O most Mighty, with Your Glory and Your Majesty. And in Your Majesty ride prosperously because of Truth and Humility and Righteousness. And **Your Right Hand** shall teach You terrible things. Your arrows are sharp in the heart of the king's enemies; whereby the people fall under You. **Your Throne, O God**, is forever and ever; the Scepter of Your Kingdom is a Scepter of Justice. You love righteousness, and hate wickedness. Therefore **God, Your God, has Anointed You** with the oil of gladness above Your companions. Instead of your fathers shall be <u>your sons</u>, whom You shall make <u>princes in all the earth</u>.

#### Psalm 48:10 Your Right Hand is full of Righteousness!

Psalm 49:7, 9, 15 (also see Psalm 41:12; Psalm 71:20) None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him. That he should still live forever, and not see corruption.

But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, for He shall receive me. (also read John 6:39, 40, 44, 54))

## Psalm 50:5 "Gather **My saints** together **to Me**, those who have made <u>a Covenant with Me</u> by sacrifice!"

Isaiah 50:6 I gave My back to the smiters, and My cheeks to those who <u>pulled out My beard</u>; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.

Psalm 53:6 (also see Psalm 14:7 and Isaiah 59:20) Oh that <u>the Salvation (ישעות) of Israel were come out of Zion</u>! When God brings back the captivity of His people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.

Psalm 65:3 (also see Psalm 79:9)Iniquities prevail against me. As for our transgressions,You will provide Atonement (Blood) for them. (see Deuteronomy 32:43)

Psalm 68:4, 18

Sing to God, sing praises to His name; **Extol Him** that rides on <u>the Clouds</u> by <u>**His name YAH**</u>, and rejoice before Him. <u>You have ascended on high</u>, <u>You have led captivity captive</u>. <u>You have received gifts among men</u>, even from the rebellious, that the LORD God might dwell among them.

Psalm 68:16 (also Genesis 22:14; Deuteronomy 12:5; Psalm 132:13, 14;) This is **the Mountain** (**Zion**) which God desires to dwell in; (Isaiah 24:23;) **yes**, <u>the LORD will dwell in it **forever**</u>! (and see Ezekiel 43:7) Psalm 69:9 Because **zeal for Your House** has eaten Me up, and the reproaches of those who reproach You have fallen on Me.

Psalm 72:1, 2, 4, 5, 7-15, 17-19 [the Messiah!] Give the king Your judgments, O God, and Your righteousness to the king's Son. He shall Judge Your people with Righteousness, and Your poor with Judgment. He shall Judge the poor of the people, He shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. They shall fear You as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. In His days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of Peace so long as the moon endures. He shall have **Dominion also from sea to sea**, and from the river to the ends of the earth. They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before Him; and His enemies shall lick the dust. The kings of Tarshish and of the isles shall bring presents; the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts. Yes, all kings shall fall down before Him: all nations shall serve Him. For He shall deliver the needy when he cries; the poor also, and him that has no helper. He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy. He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence; and precious shall their blood be in His sight. And He shall live, and to Him shall be given of the gold of Sheba. Prayer also shall be made for Him continually; and daily shall He be praised. His Name shall endure forever! His Name shall be continued as long as the sun. And men shall be blessed in Him; all nations shall call Him blessed. Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who alone does wonderful things! And blessed be His Glorious name forever! And let the whole earth be filled with His Glory. Amen.

Psalm 74:10, 11

[the Messiah!]

Oh God, how long shall the adversary reproach? Shall the enemy blaspheme Your name forever? Why withdraw **Your Hand**, even **Your Right Hand**? Take it out of Your bosom and destroy them.

Psalm 77:15 You have with Your Arm redeemed Your people ...

Psalm 80:15, 17

Return to us, <u>Oh God Almighty</u>; look down from Heaven and see and watch over **this Vine** and **the Root** which <u>Your Right Hand</u> has planted, and over <u>the Son</u> whom You made Strong for Yourself. Let Your Hand <u>be upon the Man of Your Right Hand</u>, upon **the Son of Adam** whom You made Strong for Yourself. [the Messiah!] Psalm 82:6

I said, "**You are gods,** and <u>all of you are **sons of the Most High**</u>. 82:7 <u>But you shall die like men</u>, and fall like one of the princes."

#### Psalm 89:13 You have a Mighty Arm; Strong is <u>Your Hand</u>, and high is <u>Your Right Hand</u>. [the Messiah!]

Psalm 89:3, 4, 20, 21, 26-29, 34, 35, 36, 37 (also see verses 22-25) I have made a covenant with My chosen, <u>I have sworn to David My servant</u>, <u>your **Seed** I will establish forever</u>, and build up your throne to all generations.

I have found **My servant David**; with My holy oil I have anointed him. With whom My Hand shall be established; My Arm shall also strengthen him. ... He shall cry to Me, <u>You are **my Father**</u>, **my God**, and the rock of **my Salvation**. <u>I will also make him **My firstborn**</u>, <u>highest of the kings of</u> <u>the earth</u>. My Mercy I will keep for him forevermore, and <u>My Covenant</u> <u>shall stand firm with him</u></u>. <u>I will also make His Seed</u> ... [the Messiah!] to endure forever and his Throne as the days of Heaven.

<u>My Covenant I will not break</u>, nor alter the Word that has gone out of My lips. Once again **I have sworn by My holiness**; I will not lie to David. <u>His Seed shall endure forever</u>, and <u>his Throne as the sun before Me</u>; <u>it</u> <u>shall be established forever as the moon</u>, and as a faithful witness in heaven!

[See 1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 17:3, 4, 10-14 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 7:4, 5, 11-16]

Psalm 89:48 What man is he that lives, and shall not see death? Shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave?

Psalm 98:1, 2, 3 [the Messiah!]
O sing to the LORD a new song. for He has done marvelous things!
His Right Hand and His Holy Arm have gained Him the Victory. The LORD has made known His Salvation;

**His Righteousness** He has revealed in the sight of the nations. He has remembered His mercy and His faithfulness to the house of Israel; **all the ends of the earth** <u>have seen the Salvation of our God</u>.

Psalm 102:12, 13

But You, O LORD, <u>shall endure forever</u>, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations. **You shall Arise and have Mercy on Zion**; <u>for the time to favor her</u>, Yes, <u>the appointed time has come</u>!

Psalm 102:16 The LORD shall build up Zion; He shall appear in His Glory!

Psalm 103:11, 12 (also see Micah 7:19) For as the heavens are high above the earth, <u>so great is **His Mercy**</u> toward those who fear Him. As far as the east is from the west, <u>so far has He removed our transgressions from us</u>.

Psalm 103:17

But the Mercy of the LORD is from Everlasting to Everlasting on those who fear Him ...

Psalm 105:10, 11 And confirmed it **to Jacob** for a statute, **to Israel** as **an Everlasting Covenant**, saying, "<u>To you I will give **the land of Canaan**</u> as the allotment of your inheritance," [This is found 11 places in Genesis]

### Psalm 106:48 (also see Psalm 41:13) Blessed be the LORD God of Israel from Everlasting to Everlasting!

Psalm 107:29 He makes the storm a calm, so that its waves are still.

Psalm 110:1, 4 (written by King David) <u>The LORD</u> (יהוה) said to <u>my Lord</u> (לאדני), 'Sit at My right Hand, until I make Your enemies Your footstool.' You (my Lord) are a Priest forever <u>by My Word</u> Melchi Zedek (My King of Righteousness)! [Heaven's King - High Priest is Yeshua the Messiah!]

Psalm 110:2-5 The LORD shall send the Rod of Your Strength out of Zion;
Rule in the midst of Your enemies. Your people shall be volunteers
in the Day of Your Power. The LORD has sworn, and will not relent,
'You are a Priest forever by My Word Melchi Zedek (My King of Righteousness).' The Lord at Your right hand shall execute kings in the day of His Wrath. [Heaven's King - High Priest is Yeshua, the Messiah!]

Psalm 118:15, 16[the Messiah!]The voice of Rejoicing and Salvation is in the tents of the righteous.The Right Hand of the LORD does Valiantly!The LORD is Exalted!The Right Hand of the LORD does Valiantly!

Psalm 118:22-27 <u>The STONE which the builders rejected</u> has become <u>the CORNERSTONE</u>! This is the LORD's doing; it is marvellous in our eyes. <u>This is the Day which the LORD has made</u>; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Save now, I beseech You, O LORD. O LORD, I beseech You, send prosperity now. <u>Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD</u>! We have blessed you out of the House of the LORD. God is the LORD and has given us light; Bind **the Sacrifice** with chords to the horns of the Altar. [the Messiah!]

Psalm 132:11, 12 [the Messiah!] The LORD has sworn in Truth <u>to David</u>; He will not turn from it. I will set upon <u>your throne</u> the fruit of your body. (One from the virgin!) If your sons will keep My Covenant and My testimony which I shall teach them, their sons shall also sit upon your throne <u>forevermore</u>.

Psalm 132:13, 14 (Gen 22:14; Deut 12:5; Is 24:23; 60:7, 13; Ezekiel 43:7) **For the LORD has chosen Zion**; He has desired it for His dwelling place: "**This is My resting place forever**; Here I will dwell, for I have desired it."

Psalm 132:16-18 I will also <u>clothe her priests</u> with Salvation (ישע), and her saints shall shout aloud for joy. There <u>I will make the horn of David</u> to bud; I have ordained a lamp for My Anointed. His enemies I will clothe with shame; but upon Himself His crown shall flourish

Psalm 133:1-3 A Song of David. [John 17] Behold, how good and how pleasant it is <u>for brethren to dwell together</u> <u>in unity</u>! It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, the beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments. It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon **the mountains of Zion**; for there the LORD commanded the Blessing— **Life forevermore!** 

Psalm 145:13 **Your Kingdom** is <u>an Everlasting Kingdom</u>, **[the Messiah!]** and **Your Dominion** <u>endures throughout all generations</u> (Daniel 7:13, 14)

Proverbs 4:20-23

My son, attend to **My Words**; incline your ear to My sayings. Let them not depart from your eyes; keep them in the midst of your heart. For **they are life** to those who find them, **and health** to all their flesh. Keep your heart with all diligence; for out of it proceed the issues of life.

Proverbs 11:30 He who wins souls is wise.

Proverbs 14:5, 25 A faithful witness does not lie! A true witness delivers souls.

Proverbs 16:6 (see Deuteronomy 32:43) By Mercy and Truth, <u>Atonement is provided for iniquity</u> ... Proverbs 20:9 Who can say, 'I have made my heart clean, I am pure from my sin'?

Proverbs 25:2 It is the Glory of God to conceal a matter; but it is the glory of kings **to search out a matter**.

Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? <u>What is</u>

#### His name, and what is His Son's name, if you can tell? [the Messiah!]

Ecclesiastes 7:20 For there is not a just man on the earth, that does good, and does not sin.

Ecclesiastes 12:1 Remember now **your** <u>Creators</u> (את בוראיך) plural in Hebrew) in the days of your youth, before the evil days come, and the years draw near, when you say, "I have no pleasure in them."

Song of Solomon 2:1 I am the Rose of Sharon, and the lilly of the valleys.

Song of Solomon 2:4 He brought me to the Banqueting House, **and His banner over me was Love!** 

Isaiah 1:18, 19 (also see Psalm 32:1, 2 and Micah 7:19) Come now, and let us reason together, says the LORD: <u>though **your sins**</u> be as scarlet, **they shall be as white as snow**; though they be <u>red like crimson</u>, they shall be **as wool**. **If you are willing and obedient**, <u>you shall eat the good of the land</u>...

Isaiah 4:2 [Tzemach is Yeshua, the Messiah!] In that Day <u>the Branch (Tzemach) of the LORD</u> shall be Beautiful and Glorious, and <u>the fruit (the saved remnant</u>) of the earth shall be excellent and comely for those of Israel who have escaped.

Isaiah 6:9, 10 And He said, "Go, and tell this people, 'Keep on hearing, **but do not understand**; Keep on seeing, *but do not perceive*.' "<u>Make the</u> heart of this people dull, and their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and return (to Me), **and be healed**."

#### [the Messiah!]

Isaiah 8:14, 15 And <u>He shall be for a Sanctuary</u>; but for <u>a Stone</u> of stumbling and for <u>a Rock</u> of offence to both the Houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And many among them shall stumble, and fall, and be broken, and be snared, and be taken.

#### Isaiah 8:17, 18, 23 [believers in the Messiah Yeshua!]

And I will wait for the LORD, who hides His face from the house of Jacob, and I will look for Him. Behold, **I and the children** whom the LORD has given me **are for signs and wonders in Israel** from the LORD of hosts, who dwells in Mount Zion. ...the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali ... by the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, **in the Galilee of the nations**.

Isaiah 9:1 The people that walked in darkness <u>have seen a great Light</u>; they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them <u>the Light</u> <u>has shined</u>! [the Messiah!]

Isaiah 11:1, 2, 4, 5 (see Isaiah 61:1-3 and Zechariah 3:9) **[the Messiah!]** And there shall come forth **a Rod** out of the stem of Jesse (David's father), and **a Branch** shall grow out of his roots. And <u>the Spirit of the LORD</u> <u>shall rest upon Him; the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit</u> of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD. But <u>with Righteousness</u> He shall judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth. And He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips <u>He shall slay the wicked</u>. Righteousness <u>shall be the belt of His loins</u>, and Faithfulness <u>the belt of His waist</u>.

Isaiah 11:10, 11 [the Messiah!]

"And <u>in that Day</u> there shall be **a Root of Jesse (David's father)**, who shall stand as a banner to the people; <u>for the Gentiles shall seek **Him**</u>; and <u>**His Resting Place shall be Glorious!**</u>" And it shall come to pass <u>in that</u> <u>Day</u> that <u>the LORD shall set His Hand again **the second time to recover** <u>**the remnant of His people** who are left from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.</u></u>

(Messiah's Resting Place will be on Mount Zion in Jerusalem.)

Isaiah 12:2, 3

Behold, **God is my Salvation**; I will trust, and not be afraid. For the LORD Jehovah is my strength and my song; He also has become **my Salvation**. Therefore **with Joy you shall draw water** out of **the wells of Salvation**!

Isaiah 16:5 [King – High Priest, the Messiah, Son of David and Aaron!] In Mercy the Throne will be established, and One [the King and High Priest, Messiah] shall sit on it in Truth within the Tent of David, Judging and seeking Justice, and hastening Righteousness. (Daniel 9:24) (Amos 9:11-14)

Isaiah 22:22-24[the Messiah!]The Key of the house of David I will lay upon His shoulder. AndHe shall open, and none shall shut; He shall shut, and none shall open.... and He shall be for a Glorious Throne to his father's house. Andthey shall hang upon Him all the Glory of his father (David's) house ...

Isaiah 24:23 Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when <u>the LORD of hosts</u> shall Reign <u>on Mount Zion</u>, and in Jerusalem, and before His ancients Gloriously! [the Messiah!]

Isaiah 25:6-10 (Feast of Succoth for Yeshua, His Bride, and their Guests!) And <u>in **this Mountain**</u> (Mount Zion in Jerusalem) shall **the LORD of hosts** make unto all people <u>a Feast</u> of fat things, <u>a Feast</u> of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, of wines on the lees well refined. And <u>in this</u> <u>Mountain</u> **He will destroy** the face of the covering cast over all people, and the veil that is spread over all nations. **He will swallow up death in Victory**; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from off all faces; and the rebuke of His people He shall take away from off all the earth. For the LORD has spoken. And it will be said in that Day, "Behold, **this is our God!** We have waited for Him, and He will Save us. **This is the LORD**...we will be Glad and **Rejoice** (the Feast of Succoth) **in His Salvation! For <u>in this Mountain</u>** (Mount Zion in Jerusalem), <u>the Hand of the LORD</u> shall rest ... [**The Marriage Supper of the Lamb** to be held on Mount Zion, inaugurating the 1000 year Millennial Reign of **Yeshua and His Bride** over all the earth!]

Isaiah 26:19 (see Daniel 12:1; Ezekiel 37:9-11; John 6:39, 40, 44, 54) <u>Your dead men **shall live**</u>, together with my dead body. They shall Arise. <u>Awake and Sing</u>, you who dwell in the dust; for your dew is as the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out its dead.

Isaiah 28:16 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, 'Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation <u>a STONE</u>, <u>a tried STONE</u>, <u>a precious CORNERSTONE</u>, <u>a sure Foundation</u>. He that believes shall not make haste.' [the Messiah]

Isaiah 29:10, 13 (also see Isaiah 42:19, 20 and also Habakkuk 1:5) For the LORD <u>has poured out on you **the spirit of deep sleep**, <u>& has closed</u></u> **your eyes**, namely the prophets; and **covered your heads**, namely the seers. And the Lord said, because this people draw near Me with their mouth, and honor Me with their lips, <u>but they have **removed their hearts far from Me**</u>, and their worship toward Me is taught by the rules of men.

Isaiah 33:17 Your eyes shall see <u>the King in His Beauty</u>; they shall behold the land that is very far off.

Isaiah 35:4-6 (also see Psalm 146:8; Isaiah 29:18, 19; Isaiah 42:7) Behold, **your God** will come... and save you. Then <u>the eyes of **the blind**</u> will be opened, the ears of the **deaf** shall be unstopped, the **lame** shall leap; tongue of the **dumb** sing; [Great Revival coming to ben Hinnom Valley!]

#### Isaiah 35:8, 9, 10

And <u>a Highway shall be there</u>, and <u>a Road</u>, and it shall be called **'The Highway of Holiness!'** ... <u>the Redeemed shall walk there</u>. And the Ransomed of the LORD shall return, <u>and come to Zion with songs</u> and <u>Everlasting Joy</u> upon their heads. They shall obtain Joy and Gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Isaiah 40:9, 10, 11 Say to the cities of Judah, "**Behold your God!**" Behold, <u>the Lord GOD will come with a strong Hand</u>, and <u>His Arm shall</u> <u>Rule for Him</u>. Behold, <u>His reward is with Him</u>, and His work before Him. <u>He shall feed His flock like a Shepherd</u>. He shall gather the lambs with His Arm, and carry them in His bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young. [the Messiah!]

#### [the Messiah!]

Isaiah 41:4; 44:6; 48:12 [The Aleph and the Tav; The Alpha and Omega!] Who has performed and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? 'I, the LORD, am <u>the First, and the Last</u>; I am He.' "<u>Thus says the LORD,</u> <u>the King of Israel, and His Redeemer, the LORD of hosts</u>, '<u>I am the First</u> <u>and I am the Last</u>; besides Me there is no God." "Listen to me, O Jacob and Israel, My called; I am He; <u>I Am the First, I Am also the Last</u>."

Isaiah 41:27, 28 (also see Isaiah 52:7) **[the Messiah!]** And I will give to Jerusalem <u>One who brings Good News</u>. For I looked, and there was <u>no man</u>; I looked among them, but there was <u>no counselor</u> ...

Isaiah 42:1-4, 6, 7[the Messiah!]Behold My Servant, whom I uphold; My Chosen One, in whom My SoulDelights. I have put My Spirit upon Him; He shall bring forth Justice to the

nations. He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. ... He shall bring forth Justice... He shall not fail nor be discouraged, untill He has established Justice in the earth; the isles shall wait for His Law. I the LORD have called You in Righteousness, and will hold Your Hand, and I will keep You, and give You for a (New) Covenant with the people, as a light of the Gentiles; to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

Isaiah 42:8 I am the LORD, that is My name. (Isaiah 48:11; Zech 6:13) <u>My Glory</u> I will not give to another, neither My praise to graven images.

Isaiah 43:3, 10 **[the Messiah!]** For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, <u>your Savior (מושיעך)</u>; Before Me there was no God formed, nor shall there be after Me. <u>I, even I, am the LORD</u>, <u>and besides Me there is no Savior (מושיע)</u>!

Isaiah 43:25 (also see Ezekiel 18:30-32) <u>**I**, even I am He that blots out</u> your transgressions for My own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

Isaiah 44:8 Is there a God beside Me? There is no God; <u>I know not any</u>!

Isaiah 44:22, 23 <u>I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, your transgressions</u>, and, as a cloud, your sins. <u>**Return to Me**</u>; for I have redeemed you. Sing, O you heavens; for the LORD has done it. Shout, you lower parts of the Earth. Break forth into singing, you mountains, forests, and every tree therein; for the LORD has redeemed Jacob, and glorified Himself in Israel.

Isaiah 45:2, 3, 5 I will go before you, and make the crooked places straight. I will break the gates of brass in pieces, and cut in sunder the bars of iron. And <u>I will give you **the treasures of darkness**</u>, and hidden riches of secret places, that you may know that I, the LORD, which call you by your name, am the God of Israel. **I am the LORD**, <u>and there is none else</u>, **there is no God besides Me!** 

Isaiah 45:11 Thus says the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and His Maker, "Ask Me <u>of things to come concerning **My sons**,</u> and concerning the work of My hands, you command Me!"

Isaiah 45:21-23[the Messiah!]Who has declared this from ancient times? Who has told it from that time?Have not I the LORD?And there is no other God besides Me; a just God

<u>and a Savior (ומושיע)</u>; there is none besides Me. Look to Me, and be saved <u>all the ends of the earth</u>. For <u>I am God</u>, and <u>there is no other</u>. I have sworn by Myself, the Word has gone out of My mouth in Righteousness, and shall not return, <u>that to Me every knee shall bow</u>, <u>every tongue shall swear</u>.

Isaiah 46:13

[the Messiah]

I bring near My Righteousness; it shall not be far off, and My Salvation shall not tarry. And I will place Salvation (תשועה) in Zion for Israel my Glory.

#### Isaiah 48:11 And <u>I will not give My GLORY to another</u>! (Isaiah 42:8)

Isaiah 49:5-9 (also see Isaiah 11:10) [the Messiah!] And now, says the LORD that formed Me from the womb to be His Servant, to bring Jacob to Him again, though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be Glorious in the eyes of the LORD, and My God shall be My Strength.

And He said, "It is a light thing that **You should be** <u>My Servant</u> to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel. <u>I will</u> <u>also give You as a light to the Gentiles</u>, that <u>You may be My Salvation</u> <u>to the ends of the earth</u>." Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel and His Holy One, <u>to Him whom man despises</u>, <u>to Him whom the nation abhors</u>, to <u>a Servant of rulers</u>. Kings shall see and arise, princes also <u>shall worship</u>, because of the LORD who is Faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and **He shall choose You!** 

Thus says the LORD, "In an acceptable time I have heard **You**, and <u>in **a Day of Salvation**</u> I have helped **You**; <u>and **I will preserve You**, and **give You as a (New) Covenant to the people**, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages; that You may say to the prisoners, 'Go forth'; to them that are in darkness, 'Shew yourselves.' "</u>

Isaiah 51:5, 6, 9, 12 The coastlands will wait upon Me, and **on** <u>My Arm</u> they will trust. ... <u>but My Salvation shall be forever</u>! And <u>My Righteousness</u> shall not be abolished. Awake, awake, put on strength, <u>O Arm of the LORD</u>! Awake as in the ancient days, in the generations of old. Are You not the Arm that cut Rahab apart, and wounded the serpent? <u>I, even I am He who comforts you</u>. [the Messiah!]

[the Messiah!] (also see Nahum 1:15) Isaiah 52:6, 7 Therefore <u>My people shall know My name</u>: therefore they shall know in that Day that I am He that speaks, <u>Behold, it is I!</u> ... How beautiful on the mountains are <u>the feet of Him that brings Good News</u>, who proclaims Peace; who brings glad tidings of good things, who proclaims Salvation (ישועה), who says to Zion, "Your God Reigns!" Isaiah 52:10, 13-15 (also see Psalm 22:1-31, mainly verse 16) **The LORD has made bare** <u>His Holy Arm</u> in the eyes of all the nations; and <u>all the ends of the earth shall see the Salvation of our God</u>. Behold, <u>My Servant</u> shall deal prudently, **He shall be** <u>Exalted and Extolled</u>, <u>and be very High</u>. As many were astonished at Him; <u>His visage was</u> <u>so marred more than any man</u>, and His form more than the sons of men. <u>So shall He sprinkle many nations (with His Blood)</u>; kings shall shut their mouths at Him, for that which had not been told them they shall see; & that which they had not heard shall they consider. [the Crucified Messiah!]

Isaiah 53:1, 4-6 Who has believed our report? (also see Psalm 98:1-3) And to whom has **the Arm of the LORD** [Messiah] been revealed? Surely <u>He has borne our griefs</u>, and carried our sorrows, yet we did esteem <u>Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted</u>. But <u>He was wounded for</u> <u>our transgressions</u>, <u>He was bruised</u> for our iniquities, the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with <u>His stripes</u> (Blood) we are Saved (Healed)! We all like sheep have gone astray, we have turned every one to his own way; and <u>the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all</u>.

Isaiah 53:1-12 [the Crucified Messiah!] Who has believed our report? And to whom is the Arm of the LORD revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground. He has no form nor comeliness, and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected of men; a Man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief, and we hid as it were our faces from Him. He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows. Yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities. The chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His Stripes we are Healed! All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth. He was brought as a Lamb to the slaughter, and as a Sheep before her shearers is dumb, so He opened not His mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who shall declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgression of My people He was stricken. And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You shall make His

soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. He shall see the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied! 53:11 By His knowledge <u>My Righteous Servant shall justify many</u>; for He shall bear their iniquities. Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, and <u>He shall divide the spoil with the strong</u>; because He has poured out His soul unto death. And He was numbered with the transgressors. He bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Isaiah 54:5 For **your Maker** <u>is your Husband</u>; **the LORD of hosts** is His name; and **your Redeemer** is <u>the Holy One of Israel</u>. The God of the whole earth shall He be called! (Psalm 24:10)

Isaiah 54:13 And all your children shall be taught of the LORD, and great shall be the Peace of your children.

Isaiah 55:11, 12 So shall **My Word** be that goes forth out of My mouth, <u>it shall not return to Me void</u>, <u>but **it shall accomplish** that which I please</u>, and **it shall prosper** in the thing for which I sent it. (Jeremiah 1:12)

For <u>you shall go out with **Joy**</u>, and be led forth with **Peace**. The mountains and the hills **shall break forth into singing** before you, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

Isaiah 57:13 He that puts his trust **in Me** <u>shall possess the land (of Israel)</u>, <u>and shall inherit **My holy Mountain**</u> [**Zion**] ... (Proverbs 3:5, 6)

Isaiah 59:1, 2

Behold, **the LORD'S Hand** <u>is not too short, that it cannot save</u>; neither His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. But **your iniquities** <u>have separated you</u> from your God, and **your sins** <u>have hidden His face from you</u>, so that **He will not hear**.

#### [the Coming Messiah!]

Isaiah 59:15-20 (also Isaiah 63:5, 6; Ezekiel 22:30; Psalm 14:7; 53:6) Then the LORD saw it, and it displeased Him that there was **no justice**.

And <u>He saw that there was</u> <u>no man</u>, and wondered that there was <u>no intercessor</u>. Therefore <u>His own Arm brought Salvation to Him</u>; and <u>His Righteousness</u>, it sustained Him. For <u>He put on Righteousness</u> <u>as a breastplate</u>, and <u>a helmet of Salvation upon His head</u>; and <u>He put on</u> <u>the garments of Vengeance for clothing</u>, and was clad with zeal as a cloke. According to their deeds, accordingly He will repay, wrath to His enemies, retribution to His foes; to the islands He will repay recompence. And they will fear the name of the LORD from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun. When He will come like a pent-up flood, which the Spirit of the LORD drives along. And <u>the Redeemer shall come</u> to Zion, and to them that turn from their sins in Jacob, says the LORD.

Isaiah 60:13 The glory of Lebanon shall come to you, the fir tree, the pine tree, and the box together, to beautify the place of My Sanctuary; and **I will make the place of My feet Glorious**! (Ezek 43:7)

Isaiah 61:1, 2 **[the Messiah!]** <u>The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me</u>; because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the meek; <u>He has sent Me</u> to bind up the brokenhearted, <u>to proclaim liberty to the captives</u>, and <u>the opening of the prison</u> to those who are bound; <u>to proclaim the acceptable Year of the LORD</u>, and <u>the Day of Vengeance of our God</u>; to comfort all that mourn ...

Isaiah 61:10

I will greatly <u>Rejoice in the LORD</u>, my soul shall be Joyful in my God; for <u>He has clothed me with the Garments of Salvation</u>, <u>He has covered</u> <u>me with the Robe of Righteousness</u>, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

Isaiah 62:5

For as a young man marries a virgin, so shall your sons marry you; and <u>as</u> the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God **Rejoice over you**!

Isaiah 62:11 Indeed the LORD has proclaimed to the end of the world, "Say to the daughter of Zion, '**Behold**, <u>your Salvation (ישעך) is coming</u>! Behold, <u>His Reward is with Him</u>, & <u>His Work is before Him</u>."" [Messiah!]

Isaiah 63:4, 5, 6 (see Isaiah 27:13 and Isaiah 34:8) [Messiah's Return!] For <u>the Day of Vengeance is in My heart</u>, and <u>the year of My redeemed</u> is come. And I looked, and <u>there was none to help</u>; and I wondered that <u>there was none to uphold</u>. Therefore <u>My own Arm</u> brought Salvation to Me; and My fury, it upheld me. I have trodden down the people in My anger, made they drunk in My fury. And brought down their strength...

Isaiah 63:8-10 [the Crucified Messiah!] ...He was their Saviour. In all their affliction He was afflicted, and <u>the Angel of His Presence saved them</u>. In His love and in His pity He redeemed them; and He bare them, and carried them all the days of old. But <u>they rebelled and grieved **His Holy Spirit**</u>.

Isaiah 64:6 (see Psalm 51:3 and Psalm 53:1,3) But **we are all like an unclean thing**, and <u>all our righteousnesses</u> <u>are like filthy rags</u>. We all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Isaiah 66:14 And the Hand of the LORD shall be known to His servants!

Jeremiah 1:12 (also see Isaiah 55:11) Then the LORD said to me, You have seen well, <u>for I am watching over My Word to perform it</u>!

Jeremiah 3:8 Then I saw that for all the causes for which <u>backsliding Israel</u> <u>had committed adultery</u>, <u>I had put her away and given her a Certificate of</u> <u>Divorce</u>; yet her treacherous sister Judah did not fear, but went and played the harlot also.

Jeremiah 3:12, 13 Go and proclaim these words toward the north, and say: '<u>Return, backsliding Israel</u>,' says the LORD; 'I will not cause My anger to fall on you. For I am merciful,' says the LORD; 'I will not remain angry forever. Only acknowledge your iniquity, that you have transgressed against the LORD your God, and have scattered your charms to alien deities under every green tree, and you have not obeyed My voice,' says the LORD. Jeremiah 3:14 "<u>Return, O backsliding children</u>," says the LORD; "<u>for I am married to you</u>. I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion."

Jeremiah 3:15, 23 (also see Jeremiah 23:4) And I will give you <u>shepherds according to **My heart**</u>, <u>who shall feed you</u> <u>with knowledge and understanding</u>. Truly **in the LORD** our God <u>is **the Salvation** (השועת) of Israel</u>.

Jeremiah 23:5, 6 **[the Messiah, Tzemach from king David's family!]** Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I <u>will raise up to David</u> **a Righteous Branch (Tzemach)**, and **a KING shall Reign** and Prosper, and shall execute Judgment and Justice in the earth. In His days <u>Judah</u> <u>shall be saved</u>, and Israel shall dwell safely: and <u>this is **His name**</u> whereby <u>**He** shall be called</u>, "**The LORD Our Righteousness!**" Jeremiah 23:29 Is not <u>My Word like a fire</u>, says the LORD; <u>and like a hammer</u> that breaks the rock in pieces?

Jeremiah 30:7-9 (also see Daniel 12:1-3) Alas! **For that Day is Great**, <u>so that none is like it</u>; It is even **the Time of Jacob's Trouble**; <u>but **he shall be saved out of it**</u>. For it shall come to pass in that Day, says the LORD of hosts, that I will break off the yoke from your neck, and will burst your bonds; and foreigners shall no more enslave him. <u>But they shall serve the LORD their God</u> <u>and David their king</u>, whom I will raise up for them.

Jeremiah 31:3 (also see Deuteronomy 7:6-10,12,13) The LORD has appeared of old to me, saying, **Yes, I have Loved you** <u>with an Everlasting Love</u>; therefore <u>with lovingkindness I have drawn you</u>.

Jeremiah 31:30 But every one shall die for his own iniquity.

Jeremiah 31:31-34

Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, that I will make <u>a New</u> (Blood) Covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, not according to the (blood) Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which <u>My (blood) Covenant they broke</u>, although I was a Husband to them, says the LORD. But this shall be the (New) Covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD. <u>I will put My Torah</u> <u>in their inward parts</u>, and write it in their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, "Know the LORD!"; for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For <u>I will forgive their iniquity</u>, and their sin I will remember no more. (through Messiah's Blood of the New Covenant!)

Jeremiah 32:40 "And I will make **an Everlasting Covenant** with them, that I will not turn away from <u>doing them good</u>; but I will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me.

Jeremiah 33:14-18, 24 [Messiah (Tzemach) from David's & Aaron's family!] Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that <u>I will perform that good thing</u> <u>which I have promised</u> to the House of Israel and to the House of Judah. In those days, and at that time, I will cause <u>the Branch (Tzemach)</u> <u>of Righteousness</u> to grow up unto David; and He shall execute Judgment and Righteousness in the land. In those days Judah shall be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely. And this is the name by which He shall be called in her (Jerusalem), "<u>The LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS</u>!" For thus says the LORD, "David shall never lack **a Man** to sit upon the Throne of the House of Israel. Nor shall the priests, the Levites, lack **a Man <u>before Me</u>** [means He has to be from the Zadokite high priest family, the only Aaronic priest family allowed to come before God ... Ezekiel 44: 10-16] to offer burnt offerings, and to kindle meat offerings, and to do sacrifice continually." "Have you not considered what these people have spoken, saying, <u>The two families which the LORD has chosen</u>, He has also cast them off?" [**The Messiah** born from the two families of the virgin, Isaiah 7:14: king David's family and Zadokite high priest family of Aaron. For the Messiah Yeshua, **Heaven's King and High Priest** was born <u>coming from virgin Miriam</u>; **from her father's family of king David** of the tribe <u>of Judah</u> **and her mother's family, the Zadokite high priest family!**]

Ezekiel 16:60 "Nevertheless I will remember <u>My Covenant with you</u> in the days of your youth, and I will establish **an Everlasting Covenant** with you.

Ezekiel 18:4 (also see Jeremiah 31:30) Behold, all souls are Mine; the soul of the father as well as the soul of the son is Mine. **The soul that sins** <u>shall die</u>!

Ezekiel 22:30 And <u>I sought for a man</u> among them, who should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before Me for the land, <u>that I should not destroy it</u>: <u>but I found none</u>. (also see Isaiah 59:15-20)

Ezekiel 36:25-28 (also see Ezekiel 11:19, 20; 16:60; 18:31, 32)

Then I will sprinkle <u>clean water</u> upon you, and you shall be clean. <u>I will cleanse you</u> from all your filthiness and from all your idols. <u>I will also</u> give you **a new heart**, and <u>I will put within you **a new spirit**</u>; and <u>I will take</u> away the stony heart out of your flesh, and **I will give you a heart of flesh**. And <u>I will put My Spirit within you</u>, and cause you to <u>walk in My statutes</u>, and you shall <u>keep My judgments</u>, and do them. Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be My people, and I your God.

Ezekiel 37:26 "Moreover I will make <u>a Covenant of Peace with them</u>, and it shall be **an Everlasting Covenant** with them; I will establish them and multiply them, and <u>I will set My Sanctuary in their midst forevermore</u>. Ezekiel 37:15-29: the 12 tribes of Israel will become one in Messiah's Hand!

#### Ezekiel 43:7 And He said to me, 'Son of man, [the Messiah!] this is the place of My Throne, and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever!

#### Ezekiel 43:18, 19 (also see Ezekiel 40:46; 45:3,4)

And He said to me, "Son of man, thus says the Lord GOD, 'These are the ordinances for the Altar on the day when it is made, for sacrificing burnt offerings on it, and <u>for sprinkling blood</u> on it. You shall give a young bull for a sin offering <u>to the priests</u>, the Levites, who are <u>of the seed of Zadok</u>, who approach Me to minister to Me,' says the Lord GOD.

#### Ezekiel 44:10-14

"And <u>the Levites who went far from Me</u>, when Israel went astray, who strayed away from Me after their idols, they shall bear their iniquity. Yet <u>they shall be ministers in My sanctuary</u>, as gatekeepers of the house and ministers of the house; <u>they shall slay the burnt offering and the sacrifice</u> <u>for the people</u>, and they shall stand before them to minister to them. Because they ministered to them before their idols and caused the house of Israel to fall into iniquity, therefore I have raised My hand in an oath against them," says the Lord GOD, "that they shall bear their iniquity. And <u>they shall not come near Me to minister to Me as priest</u>, nor come near any of My holy things, nor into the Most Holy Place; but they shall <u>bear their shame and their abominations</u> which they have committed. Nevertheless I will make them keep charge of the temple, for all its work, and for all that has to be done in it.

#### Ezekiel 44:15, 16

But <u>the priests</u> the Levites, <u>the sons of Zadok</u>, that kept the charge of My Sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from Me, <u>they shall</u> <u>come near to Me to minister to Me</u>. <u>And they shall stand before Me to</u> <u>offer to Me the fat and the Blood</u>, says the Lord GOD. <u>They shall enter</u> <u>into My Sanctuary</u>, <u>and they shall come near to My table</u>, to minister to Me. And they shall keep My charge.

Ezekiel 44:23, 24 "...**the sons of Zadok**... <u>they shall teach My people</u> <u>the difference between the holy and the unholy, and cause them to discern</u> <u>between the unclean and the clean</u>. In a controversy <u>they shall stand as</u> <u>judges</u>, and judge according to My judgments</u>. They shall keep My laws and statutes in all My appointed meetings, and shall hallow My Sabbaths." [Today the blood of Zadokite priests has its fulfillment <u>in Yeshua's Blood</u>, through virgin Miriam's mother! Therefore this blood is also in the spirit of all 'born again' believers in Yeshua. What does that really mean?]

#### Ezekiel: 48:10, 11 (also see Ezekiel 45:4)

"The Sanctuary of the LORD shall be in the center. <u>It shall be for priests</u> of the sons of Zadok, ... sanctified, who have kept My charge, who did not go astray when the children of Israel went astray, as the Levites went stray."

#### Daniel 2:34, 35 [the Coming Messiah!]

You watched until <u>a STONE</u> was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and broke them to pieces. ... <u>the STONE</u> (Messiah) that smote the image <u>became a Great Mountain</u>, <u>and filled the whole earth</u>. (see also Psalm 118:22-27 and Isaiah 28:16)

Daniel 2:44 And in the days of these kings, **the God of Heaven shall set up a Kingdom which shall never be destroyed**; and the Kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and **it shall stand forever!** 

#### Daniel 3:24, 25 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spoke, and said to his counsellors, "Did we not cast three men bound into the midst of the fire?" They answered and said to the king, "True, O king." He answered and said, "Oh, <u>I see four men loose and walking in the midst of the fire</u>, and they have no hurt; and **the form of the fourth is like <u>the Son of God</u>!"** 

Daniel 7:9, 13, 14 [the Resurrected Messiah!]

I watched till <u>Thrones</u> were put in place, and <u>the Ancient of Days</u> was seated; His garment was white as snow, the hair of His head like pure wool... I saw in the night visions, and, behold, <u>one like the Son of man</u> came with the Clouds of Heaven, <u>and came to the Ancient of days</u>, and they brought Him near before Him. And there was given Him Dominion, <u>and Glory</u>, and a Kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages should serve Him. His Dominion <u>is an everlasting Dominion</u>, which shall not pass away, and His Kingdom that which shall not be destroyed. (see Psalm 145:13)

#### Daniel 7:18, 27

But <u>the saints of the Most High shall receive the Kingdom</u>, <u>and possess the Kingdom forever</u>, even for ever and ever. Then the Kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the Kingdom under the whole heaven shall be given to the people, <u>the saints of the Most High</u>. His Kingdom is an Everlasting Kingdom, <u>and all dominions shall serve and obey Him</u>. (Psalm 145:13)

#### Daniel 9:24-27 [the Crucified Messiah!]

"Seventy Weeks are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation

for iniquity, <u>to bring in Everlasting Righteousness</u>, to seal up vision and prophesy, and **to anoint the Most Holv**."

"Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the command to restore and build Jerusalem <u>until Messiah the Prince</u>, there shall be <u>Seven</u> <u>Weeks and Sixty two Weeks</u>. The street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times." And <u>after Sixty two Weeks</u> <u>Messiah shall be</u> <u>cut off</u>, <u>but not for Himself</u>! And the people of the prince that shall come (from the Romans) <u>shall destroy the city (Jerusalem) and the Sanctuary</u>. [This happened almost 2000 years ago!] <u>The end of it shall be with a flood</u>, until the end of the war desolations are determined. Then he (anti-Messiah) shall confirm a covenant with many <u>for one week</u>; but in **the middle of the Week (3 \frac{1}{2} / 7 years**) he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate."

#### Daniel 10:5, 6, 14, 21 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

Then I lifted up my eyes, and looked, and behold <u>one Man clothed</u> in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz. His body also was like beryl, and <u>His face as the appearance of lightning</u>, and <u>His eyes</u> <u>as lamps of fire</u>, and His arms and His feet like in color to polished bronze, and the Voice of His Words like the Voice of a multitude. [The Messiah!] 'Now I have come to make you understand <u>what shall befall your people</u> in the latter days, for the vision is yet for many days. But I will shew you what is noted in the Scripture of Truth. And there is none that stands with Me in these things, but Michael your prince.'

Daniel 12:2 (also see Isaiah 26:19 and Hosea 13:14) And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth <u>shall Awake</u>, <u>some to Everlasting Life</u>, and <u>some to shame and Everlasting contempt</u>.

#### Daniel 12:6, 7 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

And he said to <u>the Man clothed in linen</u>, who was above the waters of the river, "How long shall it be to the fulfillment of these wonders?" And I heard <u>the Man clothed in linen</u>, who was above the waters of the river, when <u>He held up His right hand and His left hand to heaven, and</u> <u>swore by Him who lives forever</u>, "that it shall be for a time, times, and a half; and <u>when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered</u>, all these things shall be finished." (also see Deuteronomy 32:39, 40) Hosea 1:10 Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come t to pass, that in the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, there it shall be said to them, "<u>You are sons of the Living God</u>!"

Hosea 3:4, 5 For the children of Israel shall abide many days <u>without a king</u>, and <u>without a prince</u>, and <u>without a sacrifice</u>, and without an image, and without an ephod, and without teraphim. Afterward shall the children of Israel return, <u>and seek the LORD their God and David their king</u>; and shall fear the LORD and His Goodness in the latter days.

Hosea 5:15[the Risen Messiah!]I will go and return to My place, <u>until they acknowledge their sin</u>,and seek My face.In their affliction they will seek Me earnestly...

Hosea 6:1 Come, <u>and let us return to the LORD</u>; for He has torn, <u>but He</u> <u>will heal us</u>; He has stricken, <u>but He will bind us up</u>. 6:2 After two days He will revive us; <u>on the third day **He will raise us up**, **that we may live** <u>in His sight</u>. 6: 3 Let us know, let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning; <u>He will come to us</u> <u>like the rain</u>, <u>like the latter and former rain to the earth</u>.</u>

Hosea 11:10, 11 **[the Messiah!]** (Jer 25:30-33; Joel 3:16-18; Amos 1:2) They shall walk after the LORD, and <u>He shall Roar like a lion</u>! When **He Roars**, then His children <u>shall come trembling from the west</u>. They <u>shall come trembling as a bird out of Egypt</u>, and <u>as a dove out of</u> the land of Assyria. And I will settle them in their houses, says the LORD.

Hosea 12:3, 4 And in his (Jacob's) strength <u>he struggled with God</u>. Yes, he struggled with <u>the Angel</u> and overcame. (see Zechariah 12:8) [the Messiah!]

Hosea 13:4, 14 Yet <u>I am the LORD your God</u> from the land of Egypt, and <u>you shall know **no God but Me**</u>; for <u>there is no Saviour besides Me</u>. I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death. **O Death**, <u>I will be your plagues</u>! **O Grave**, <u>I will be your destruction</u>!

Amos 3:7 Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, <u>unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets</u>. (also see 2nd Chronicles 20:20 and Isaiah 44:26) Amos 8:9, 10 "And it shall come to pass in that day", says the Lord GOD, "that I will cause <u>the sun to go down at noon</u>, and <u>I will **darken the earth** in broad daylight</u>. I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation. I will bring sackcloth on every waist, and baldness on every head. <u>I will make it **like mourning for an only son**</u>, and its end like a bitter day. [Messiah's Crucifixion Day!]

#### Amos 9:11, 12, 13, 14

**"In that Day**, <u>I will raise up **the Succah of David**</u> that is fallen, and close up its breaches; and I will raise up its ruins, and I will build it as in the days of old. <u>That they may possess the remnant of Edom</u>, <u>and of all the peoples</u> <u>who are called by My name</u>," says the LORD... "Behold, the days are coming," says the LORD, "<u>when the plowman shall overtake the reaper and</u> <u>the treader of grapes him who sows seed</u>; [**the Great End Time Harvest**] The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, and all the hills shall flow with it. I will bring back the captives of My people Israel;" (see Isaiah 16:5)

#### Micah 2:12, 13

"I will surely assemble all of you, O Jacob, I will surely gather <u>the remnant</u> <u>of Israel</u>. I will put them together like sheep of the fold, like a flock in the midst of their pasture. They shall make a loud noise because of so many people. <u>The Breaker shall come up before them</u>; they shall break out, pass through the gate, and go out by it. <u>Their king will pass before them</u>, with <u>the LORD at the head</u>."

## Micah 4:7 And the LORD shall Reign over them in Mount Zion from now on, even forever!

Habakkuk 3:8 O LORD, were You displeased with the rivers, was Your anger against the rivers, was Your Wrath against the sea, that You rode on Your horses, **Your chariots of Salvation**? (see Joel 2:11)

Habakkuk 3:13 You went forth **for the Salvation of Your people**, for Salvation with Your Anointed. You struck the head from the house of the wicked, by laying bare from foundation to neck. Selah

Haggai 2:7, 9[the Coming Messiah!]And I will shake all nations, and 'the Desire of all nations' shall come!And I will fill this House with Glory, says the LORD of hosts.The Glory of this latter House shall be Greater than the former, says theLORD of hosts.And in this Place I will give Peace, says the LORD of hosts.

#### Zechariah 2:10-12 [the Returning Messiah!]

Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion. **For, Behold, <u>I am Coming</u>**, and I will dwell in your midst, says the LORD. Many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that Day, and <u>they shall be My people</u>; and I will dwell in your midst, and you shall know that <u>the LORD of hosts has sent Me to you</u>. And the LORD will take possession of Judah as His inheritance in the Holy Land, and <u>will again choose Jerusalem</u>.

Zechariah 3:1-6, 7, 8, 9 **[the Messiah from Zadokite high priest family!]** Then he shewed me <u>Yehoshua, the high priest</u> (from the Zadokite high priest family of Aaron) standing before the Angel (Messenger) of the LORD, and Satan standing at His right hand to oppose him.

And the LORD said to Satan, The LORD rebuke you, Satan; the LORD that has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you. Is this not a brand plucked out of the fire? Now Yehoshua <u>was clothed with filthy garments</u>, and stood before the Angel. Then He answered and spake to those that stood before him, saying, "Take away the filthy garments from him." And to him He said, "See, <u>I have removed your iniquity from you</u>, and I will clothe you with rich robes." And I said, "Let them put a clean turbin on his head." So they put a clean turbin on his head, and they put the clothes on him. And the Angel of the LORD stood by.

Then the Angel of the LORD admonished Yehoshua, saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts ... Hear now, **O Yehoshua**, **the high priest** (of Zadok), you, and your companions that sit before you: for they are men wondered at. For, behold, <u>I am bringing forth **My Servant "the Branch (Tzemach)!**" For behold **the Stone** that I have laid before Yeshua; upon **one Stone** <u>shall be seven eyes</u>. Behold, I will engrave its inscription, says the LORD of hosts, and **I will remove the iniquity of that land <u>in one day</u>.</u>** 

[This Zadok high priest Yehoshua is also called Yeshua in Ezra 3:2]

Zechariah 6:11, 12, 13 Take silver and gold and <u>make crowns</u>, and put on the head of <u>Yehoshua, the high priest</u>, the son of Jeho-zadok. Then speak to him (Yeshua, in Ezra 3:2), saying, "Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying, 'Behold <u>the Man whose name is the Branch (Tzemach</u>); and He shall grow up out of His place, and <u>He shall build the Temple of the LORD</u>. Yes, <u>He shall build the Temple of the LORD</u>; & <u>He shall bear the Glory</u>, & shall sit and <u>rule upon His Throne</u>; & <u>He shall be a Priest</u> upon His Throne; and the counsel of <u>Peace shall be between Them both</u>." [King Priest!]

King - High Priest Yeshua is Messiah, Tzemach, Branch of the LORD!

Zechariah 9:9-11[the Crucified Messiah!]Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem.Behold, your King comes to you; He is Just, and having Salvation;lowly, and riding on an ass, upon a colt, the foal of an ass.He shall speak Peace to the nations, and His Dominion shall beeven from sea to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth.As for you also, by the (MESSIAH'S) Blood of your (New) CovenantI have sent forth your prisoners...

Zechariah 9:14, 15, 16 (also see Isaiah 27:13) **[the Returning Messiah!]** And **the LORD** shall be seen over them, and His arrow shall go forth as the lightning; and <u>the LORD God shall blow the Shofar</u>, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south. <u>The LORD of hosts shall defend them</u>; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones... And <u>the LORD</u> <u>their God shall save them</u> in that Day <u>as the flock of His people</u>...

Zechariah 12:8, 9, 10 (see Hosea 12:3, 4) **In that Day** <u>the LORD</u> <u>shall defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem</u>; and he that is feeble among them in that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be <u>as God</u>, <u>as the Angel of the LORD</u> before them. It shall be **in that Day** that <u>I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem</u>. 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of Grace and of Supplication, and **[the Messiah]** 

they shall look upon Me whom they have Pierced, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourns for <u>his only son</u>, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for <u>his firstborn</u>.

Zechariah 13:1 In that Day <u>a Fountain shall be opened</u> to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem <u>for sin and for uncleanness</u>.

Zechariah 13:7-9 **[the Crucified Messiah!]** Awake, O Sword, <u>against **My Shepherd**</u>, and <u>against **the Man that is close to Me**, says the LORD of hosts. **Strike the Shepherd**, and the sheep shall <u>be scattered</u>; and I will turn My hand upon the little ones. And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, says the LORD, two parts shall be cut off and die; but <u>the third shall be left</u>. <u>And I will bring the third part through</u> <u>the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold</u> <u>is tried</u>. They shall call on My name, <u>and I will answer them</u>. I will say, 'This is My people', and they shall say, 'The LORD is my God!'</u> Zechariah 14:9

# And the LORD shall be KING over all the earth! In that Day shall there be **One LORD, and His name One**!

Malachi 2:7

### For <u>the lips of a priest should keep knowledge</u>, and they should seek **the Torah** from his mouth; for he is **the messenger** of the LORD of hosts.

Malachi 3:1-3 Behold, **I will send My messenger**, and <u>he shall prepare the way before Me</u>. And the Lord, whom you seek, shall <u>suddenly come to His Temple</u>, even the Messenger of the Covenant, whom you delight in. Behold, <u>He shall Come</u>, says the LORD of hosts.

But who can endure the Day of His Coming, and who can stand when He appears? For **He is like a refiner's Fire**, and like a launderers soap. And He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver; and <u>He shall purify</u> the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer to the LORD an offering in righteousness.

Malachi 3:16-18 Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, and the LORD listened, and heard them. So <u>a Book of remembrance</u> was written before Him for those who feared the LORD, and who thought upon His name. "<u>They shall be Mine</u>," says the LORD of hosts, "in that Day when I make them **My jewels**. <u>And I will spare them</u>, as a man spares his <u>own son who serves him</u>. Then you shall discern between the righteous and the wicked, between <u>him who serves God</u> and him who does not serve Him."

#### Malachi 4:2, 3 [the Coming Messiah!]

But to you that fear My name **the Sun of Righteousness** shall arise **with healing** in His wings; and you shall go out, and grow fat like calves of the stall. You shall trample the wicked, for <u>they shall be ashes under</u> the souls of your feet on the Day that I do this, says the LORD of hosts.

John 8:31 Then <u>Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him</u>, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. 8:32 And <u>you shall</u> <u>know the Truth</u>, **and the Truth shall make you free**!" 8:34 Yeshua answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. 8:35 And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. 8:36 Therefore <u>if the Son makes you free</u>, **you shall be free indeed**!"

## Conclusions of this writer ...

As an American Israeli Jewish believer in Yeshua living in Jerusalem for the last 26 years, I truly believe that one of the main **strongholds** over Israel comes from <u>the Israeli Orthodox religious</u> Jews who have left the written Word of God for <u>their Oral Torah</u>, which they claim was originally given by God to Moses at Mount Sinai. Both Israeli Orthodox religious and secular Jews have been greatly deceived by forsaking **full attention to God's divine Written Word** given by God to Moses at Mount Sinai; for they have believed that God also gave Moses **a divine Oral Law**, <u>which can't be proven from any Scriptures</u>. Orthodox religious Jews have placed a major focus on a supposed **divine Rabbical Talmud** and **Mishna Oral Torah**, which did not come from God!

This has become **very great idolatry** that has blinded religious Jews, so they are not able to see Yeshua as their Messiah in the more than 220 Torah and Tanakh Messianic Scripture prophesies. This Oral Torah <u>tradition</u> is definitely a very great deception. The Oral Torah can easily **be proven incorrect** with a thorough study of God's Written Word from both the Torah and the Tanakh!

It would have been a lot more honest to just have said that <u>the</u> <u>Oral Torah, or Talmud, is really oral traditions</u>: teachings, customs, opinions of the Jewish sages, leaders, and scholars <u>handed down</u> <u>from mouth to mouth throughout the centuries</u>. These were first written down around the late 200 C.E. by Rabbi Judah Hanasi as the Mishna. These <u>were not something given by God to Moses</u> <u>at Mount Sinai</u> as separate teachings from the written Word. It may also be fair to say that this was done to make sure that <u>our</u> <u>Jewish people **would not be able to see Yeshua as their true** <u>Messiah prophesied in the Holy Scriptures</u>, since the Oral Torah was written 200 years after Yeshua had come to earth, and after dying as our Savior for the sins of our Jewish people.</u>

**Exodus 34:27** Then the LORD said to Moses, "**Write these Words**, for in accordance with **these Words I have made a Covenant with you and with Israel**." 34:28 So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he neither ate bread nor drank water. And He wrote on the tablets the Words of the Covenant, **the Ten Commandments**.

**Deuteronomy 4:2** "You shall <u>not add to the Word</u> which I command you, <u>nor take from it</u>, that you may keep the Commandments of the LORD your God which I command you."

**Deuteronomy 8:2, 3** "And you shall remember that the LORD your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you and test you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His Commandments or not. So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that <u>man shall not live</u> by bread alone; <u>but man lives by every Word</u> that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD!"

**Deuteronomy 12:26** "Only the holy things which you have, and your vowed offerings, you shall take and go to the place which the LORD chooses. 12:27 And you shall offer your burnt offerings, the meat and the blood, on the altar of the LORD your God; and the blood of your sacrifices shall be poured out on the altar of the LORD your God, and you shall eat the meat. 12:28 \*\*\* Observe and obey <u>all these Words</u> which I command you, that it may go well with you and your children after you forever, when you do what is good and right in the sight of the LORD your God." 12:32 (13:1) "Whatever I command you, <u>be careful to observe it</u>; you shall <u>not add to it nor take away from it</u>!"

**Deuteronomy 17:18** "Also it shall be, when he (the king) sits on the throne of his kingdom, that <u>he shall write for himself a copy of this</u> <u>Torah in a book</u>, from the one before the priests, the Levites. 17:19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that <u>he may learn to fear the LORD his God</u> and be careful to observe all the words of this Torah and these statutes, 17:20 <u>that his heart may</u>

**Deuteronomy 28:1** "Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His <u>Commandments</u> which I command you today, that the LORD your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. 28:2 And <u>all these</u> <u>blessings shall come upon you and overtake you</u>, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God: 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His Commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that **all these curses will come upon you and overtake you**: 28:16 "Cursed shall you be in the city, and cursed shall you be in the country."

**Deuteronomy 28:58 "If you do not carefully observe all the Words of this Torah <u>that are written in this Book</u>, that you may fear this glorious and awesome name, the LORD your GOD, 28:59 then the LORD will bring upon you and your descendants <u>extraordinary plagues</u>... <u>prolonged plagues</u>... prolonged sicknesses. 28:60 Moreover He will bring back on you all the <u>diseases of Egypt</u>, of which you were afraid, and they shall cling to you. 28:61 Also every sickness and every plague which is not written in this Book of the Torah, will the LORD bring upon you until you are destroyed."** 

**Deuteronomy 30:8** "And you will again obey the voice of the LORD and do all His Commandments which I command you today. 30:9 The LORD your God will make you abound in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For the LORD will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers, 30:10 if you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep His Commandments and His statutes which are written in this Book of the Law, and if you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. 30:11 For this commandment which I command you today is not too mysterious for you, nor is it far off. 30:12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend into heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' 30:13 Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' 30:14 But the Word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it. 30:15 See, I have set

before you today <u>life and good, death and evil</u>, 30:16 in that I command you today <u>to love the LORD your God</u>, <u>to walk in His ways</u>, and to keep **His Commandments**, **His statutes**, and **His judgments**, that you may <u>live and multiply</u>; and the LORD your God will bless you in the land which you go to possess. 30:17 But if your heart turns away so that you do not hear, and are drawn away, and <u>worship other gods and serve</u> <u>them</u>, 30:18 I announce to you today that <u>you shall surely perish</u>; 30:19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that <u>I have set</u> <u>before you Life and Death</u>, <u>blessing and cursing</u>; <u>therefore **choose Life**, <u>that both you and your descendants may live</u>; 30:20 <u>that you may love</u> <u>the LORD your God</u>, <u>that you may obey His voice</u>, and that you may <u>cling to Him</u>, for He is your Life and the length of your days; and that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them."</u>

**Deuteronomy 31:10** And Moses commanded them, saying, "<u>At the end of every seven years</u>, at the appointed time in the year of Release, <u>at the Feast of Tabernacles</u>, 31:11 when all Israel comes to appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses, **you shall read this Torah before all Israel in their hearing**. 31:12 Gather the people together, men and women and little ones, and the stranger who is within your gates, **that they may hear** <u>and that they may learn to fear the LORD your God</u> **and carefully observe all the Words of this Torah**, 31:13 and that their children, who have not known it, may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God as long as you live in the land which you cross the Jordan to possess."

**Deuteronomy 31:24** So it was, when Moses had completed <u>writing</u> <u>the Words of this Torah in a Book</u>, when they were finished, 31:25 that Moses commanded the Levites, who bore the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD, saying, 31:26 "<u>Take this Book of the Torah, and put</u> <u>it beside the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD your God</u>, that it may be there as a witness against you; 31:27 for I know your rebellion and your stiff neck. If today, while I am yet alive with you, you have been rebellious against the LORD, then how much more after my death? 31:28 Gather to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, <u>that</u> <u>I may speak these Words in their hearing</u> and call heaven and earth to witness against them. 31:29 For I know that after my death you will become utterly corrupt, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you. And evil will befall you in the latter days, because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger through the work of your hands." **Deuteronomy 32:43** "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and render vengeance to His adversaries; <u>He will provide Atonement for His land and His people</u> (through the Messiah)." 32:44 So Moses came with Joshua the son of Nun and spoke all the words of this song in the hearing of the people. 32:45 Moses finished speaking all these words to all Israel, 32:46 and he said to them, "Set your hearts on all the words which I testify among you today, which <u>you shall command your sons to be careful to obey</u> <u>all the Words of this Torah</u>. 32:47 For it is not a futile thing for you, because it is your life, and <u>by this Word you shall prolong your days in the land</u> which you cross over the Jordan to possess."

#### **Eight Other Places in Tanakh forbid Israel to leave the Written Word!**

Joshua 1:1 After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, it came to pass that <u>the LORD spoke to Joshua</u> the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying, 1:2 "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them, the children of Israel. 1:8 <u>This Book of the Torah shall not</u> depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, then you will have good success."

Joshua 8:34 And afterward <u>he read all the words of the Torah</u>, the blessings and the cursings, <u>according to all that is written in the Book</u> <u>of the Torah</u>. 8:35 <u>There was not a word of all that Moses had</u> <u>commanded which Joshua did not read before all the assembly of Israel</u>, with the women, the little ones, and the strangers who were living <u>among them</u>. [Joshua read all the words of God to the people from the written Book of the Torah of Moses; for no oral Torah existed then!]

Joshua 23:6 Therefore be very courageous <u>to keep and to do all</u> <u>that is written in the Book of the Torah of Moses</u>, lest you turn aside from it to the right hand or to the left ...

**Proverbs 30:4-6** Who has ascended into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? <u>What is His</u> <u>name</u>, **and what is His Son's name**, if you know? Every Word of God is pure; He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him. <u>Do not add</u> <u>to His words</u>, lest He rebuke you, and <u>you be found a liar</u>! **Isaiah 59:21** "As for Me," says the LORD, "<u>this is My Covenant with</u> <u>them</u>. <u>My Spirit who is upon you</u>, and <u>My Words which I have put in</u> <u>your mouth</u>, <u>shall not depart from your mouth</u>, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants' descendants," says the LORD, "from this time and forevermore."

An event in king David's life proved that there was no Oral Torah ...

1 Chronicles 15:13 "For because you did not do it the first time, the LORD our God broke out against us, <u>because we did not consult</u> <u>Him about the proper order</u>." 15:14 So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the Ark of the LORD God of Israel. 15:15 And the children of the Levites bore the Ark of God on their shoulders, by its poles, <u>as Moses had commanded according to</u> <u>the Word of the LORD</u>.

400 years later <u>a major historical discovery</u> happened in Jerusalem which again also <u>proved that there was no such thing as an **Oral Torah!** King Josiah lived from 640 BC to 610 BC (around 620 B.C.) The high priest Hilkiah found <u>the Book of the Torah</u> in the House of God, which king Josiah than had read to all the people ... This also proved that the Aaronic priests had no Oral Torah!</u>

**2 Kings 22:3** Now it came to pass, in the eighteenth year of King Josiah ... 22:8 Then Hilkiah the high priest said to Shaphan the scribe, "I have found the Book of the Torah in the house of the LORD." And Hilkiah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it. 22:9 So Shaphan the scribe went to the king, bringing the king word, saying, "Your servants have gathered the money that was found in the House, and have delivered it into the hand of those who do the work, who oversee the House of the LORD." 22:10 Then Shaphan the scribe showed the king, saying, "Hilkiah the (high) priest has given me a book." And Shaphan read it before the king. 22:11 Now it happened, when the king heard the Words of the Book of the Torah, that he tore his clothes. 22:12 Then the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, Ahikam the son of Shaphan, Achbor the son of Michaiah, Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah a servant of the king, saying, 22:13 "Go, inquire of the LORD for me, for the people and for all Judah, concerning the Words of this Book that has been found; for great is the wrath of the LORD that is aroused against us, because our fathers have not obeyed the Words of this Book, to do according to all that is written concerning us."

**2 Kings 23:1** Now the king (Josiah) sent them to gather all the elders of Judah and Jerusalem to him. 23:2 The king went up to the House of the LORD with all the men of Judah, and with him all the inhabitants of Jerusalem—the priests and the prophets and all the people, both small and great. And he read **in their hearing <u>all the Words of the Book of</u> <u>the Covenant which had been found in the House of the LORD</u>. 23:3 Then the king stood by a pillar and made a covenant before the LORD, to follow the LORD and to keep His commandments and His testimonies and His statutes, with all his heart and all his soul, <u>to perform the Words of this Covenant that were <b>written in this Book**. And all the people took a stand for the Covenant.</u>

**Nehemiah 8:1** Now all the people gathered together as one man in the open square that was in front of the Water Gate; and they told Ezra the scribe to bring the Book of the Torah of Moses, which the LORD had commanded Israel. 8:2 So Ezra the priest brought the Torah before the assembly of men and women and all who could hear with understanding on the first day of the seventh month.

[This is the Fifth Feast of the LORD found in Leviticus 23:24, 25]

8:3 Then he read from it in the open square that was in front of the Water Gate from morning until midday, before the men and women and those who could understand; and the ears of all the people were attentive to the Book of the Torah. 8:5 And Ezra opened the Book in the sight of all the people, for he was standing above all the people; and when he opened it, all the people stood up. 8:6 And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. Then all the people answered, "Amen, Amen!" while lifting up their hands. And they bowed their heads and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground. 8:7 Also Yeshua (the priest) ... and the Levites, helped the people to understand the Torah; and the people stood in their place. 8:8 So they read distinctly from the Book, in the Torah of God; and they gave the sense, and helped them to understand the reading. 8:9 And Nehemiah, who was the governor, Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who taught the people said to all the people, "This day is holy to the LORD your God (the Fifth Feast of Leviticus 23:2, 25); do not mourn nor weep." For all the people wept, when they heard the Words of the Torah. 8:10 Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the Joy of the LORD is your Strength."

In Nehemiah 8:1-10 we see <u>many important things</u>: that there was no Oral Torah being used, and that <u>the religious corruption of the Word of God</u> <u>of Moses had not yet begun when priest Ezra returned from exile in</u> <u>Babylon</u>, for the 7<sup>th</sup> month was called just that, <u>the 7<sup>th</sup> month</u>, without giving it a name (1 Kings 8:2, the 7<sup>th</sup> month was called Ethanim in days of Solomon), later it was <u>corrupted by the religious Orthodox Jews</u>, who called the seventh month by the name Tishri, the Babylonian name for Babylon's <u>7<sup>th</sup> month</u>.

Also <u>the first day of the seventh month</u> was the date in Leviticus 23:23, 24 that God had announced for God's <u>fifth Feast of the LORD</u>. That is why Ezra and the other leaders said that <u>this day was holy to the LORD</u>.

Later the Orthodox religious Jews changed <u>the name of this feast of the</u> <u>1<sup>st</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month</u> from the name God gave it in Leviticus 23:24, Zichron Teruah, and in Numbers 29:1, Yom Teruah) to **Rosh Ha Shanah**, **Jewish New Years**, named after the Babylonian New Years day held on the first day of their seventh month. And this brought in deception both to God's 7<sup>th</sup> month, and also to God's holy Fifth Feast of Leviticus 23. This change was also in direct violation of God's Word in Exodus 12:2, where God explicitly said that the first day of the first month (Aviv), the month of Passover, would be Israel's New Years.

Exodus 12:1 Now the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, 12:2 "This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you."

These 20 Scriptures prove <u>the written Torah</u> was all that Israel had, and also what Israel was commanded by God to obey! God never gave to Moses a separate divine Oral Torah at Mount Sinai, or anywhere else!

#### This Writer's Conclusions

Many great deceptions <u>have come into Judaism</u> through Orthodox religious Judaism. This great deception of their claim of <u>a divine Oral Torah</u> has opened so many Jewish souls <u>to great idolatry</u> and much deception. The Oral Torah has blinded Israel and probably caused **their Greatest Sin:** they were unable to see <u>their own God became their Savior and Messiah</u>, who lived with them and died to save them from all of their sins. Their true Messiah, Yeshua, had been prophesied <u>in over 220 Scriptures</u> in the Hebrew Holy Scriptures, in both the Torah and in the Tanakh. Father God loves the Orthodox religious Jews, and He wants them to know His Son Yeshua as their Messiah and Savior, who died for all their sins, in order to be able to give them into Eternal Life and Eternal Salvation.

Why did God give Israel a New Covenant?

It is of great importance to understand the reasons why God, out of His great love and mercy for Israel and Judah, had first announced that He would be <u>making a New Covenant with Israel</u>. God had said this because so **many times the people of Israel had** <u>broken God's Covenant</u> which Israel had made with God at Mount Sinai. This was also because of the traditions of men, which the people held above the Commandments of God. Read Mark 7:9, He (Yeshua) said to them, "All too well you reject the Commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition."

Jeremiah 31:31 "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make **a New Covenant** with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, 31:32 not according to the Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My Covenant **which they broke** (made at Sinai), though I was a Master to them, says the LORD. 31:33 But this is the Covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My Torah in their minds, and write (My words) it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 31:34 No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

This New Covenant had to be <u>ratified with blood</u>, just as God's first Covenant given to Israel at Mount Sinai was also ratified with blood by Moses. See Exodus 24:6-8 <u>But whose blood would be used</u> to ratify this New Covenant, since this New Covenant was to be very different from the Covenant which God had made with Israel at Mount Sinai? For it had been announced ahead of time that not only would God's Torah <u>now be</u> <u>written internally</u>, putting this Torah on our mind and also writing it on our heart, <u>but also that our iniquities would now be forgiven</u>, <u>and that our sins</u> <u>would be remembered no more</u>.

Whose Blood would be used <u>for our Atonement</u>, since the Torah would be put inside of us, and all our sins would be forgiven? <u>Only sinless Blood</u>! This New Covenant would be <u>ratified by God</u> using **the sinless Blood of** <u>the Lamb of God</u>, the only begotten Son of God, God's Son Yeshua! This had been repeatedly prophesied throughout God's Holy Word!

#### Genessis 22:8 And Abraham said (to his son Isaac), "My son, God will provide for Himself <u>the Lamb for a burnt offering</u>!"

This atonement had also been announced in Deuteronomy 32:43, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and render vengeance to His adversaries; **He will provide** <u>Atonement</u> for His land and His people."

Leviticus 17:11 "For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul."

This is also found in the amazing mystery in one of the most powerful Old Testament Scriptures <u>that is still totally missed</u>. It is **Jeremiah 33:18**. "Nor shall the priests, the Levites, lack **a Man** <u>before Me</u> to offer burnt offerings, to kindle grain offerings, and to do <u>an animal blood sacrifice</u> for all days."

It shows that a Man from within the Aaronic priest family, specifically the family of the Zadokite high priests, the only family of Aaron that God allowed to come before God, and to do <u>an animal blood sacrifice</u> before God (Ezekiel 44:10-16), does this sacrifice continually." The Hebrew says, 'sevah kol ha yamin', an animal blood sacrifice for all days!

What animal was being sacrificed in this Scripture passage? Here we see the Great High Priest of Heaven, Yeshua, Melchi Zedek (My King of Righteousness) offering up Himself as **the Lamb of God**, the Lamb slain from before the foundation of the world. (Revelation 13:8)

This Man was never an Aaronic priest since He had no earthly father, but He is always from the Aaronic priest family, since He was born from the two families of the virgin, His mother Miriam, coming from king David's family and also from the Zadokite high priest family of Aaron. See Genesis 3:15; Psalm 132:11; and Isaiah 7:13, 14;

Yeshua's sinless Blood was the price that God paid for the sins of all humanity, and also to purchase back the earth! God had prophesied about His Son being our Messiah and Savior in over 220 Messianic Scriptures prophesies in both the Torah and the Tanakh. That God's Son would die on a tree (Deuteronomy 21:22, 23) taking our place for all of our sins. Jeremiah 1:12 Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for I am ready to perform My Word."

Jeremiah 23:29 "Is not <u>My Word like a fire</u>?" says the LORD, "<u>And like a hammer</u> that breaks the rock in pieces?"

Hebrews 4:12 For <u>the Word of God is living and powerful</u>, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 4:13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

Read the Words of God's Son, God's Righteous Servant. Especially read Isaiah 53:1-12; Isaiah 9:6, 7; Isaiah 7:13, 14; Jeremiah 33:14-24; Zechariah 12:10. This Truth is found in dozens of other major Scripture prophesies.

Listen to some of the Words of Yeshua about His Heavenly Father ...

John 8:31 Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. 8:32 And <u>you</u> <u>shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free</u>!" 8:34 Yeshua answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. 8:35 And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. 8:36 Therefore <u>if the Son makes you free</u>, you shall be free indeed!"

#### "I and My Father are One!" John 10:30

Matthew 11:27 "All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except My Father. Nor does anyone know My Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him."

John 8:29 "And He who sent Me is with Me. My Father has not left Me alone, **for I always do those things that please Him!**"

John 10:17 "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My Life that I may take it again. 10:18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have Power to lay it down, and I have Power to take it again. This Command I have received from My Father."

#### John 11:25 Yeshua said to her, "I am the Resurrection and the Life! He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. 11:26 And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"

John 14:9 Yeshua said to him, "He who has seen Me has seen My Father; 14:10 Do you not believe that I am in My Father, and My Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own Authority; but My Father who dwells in Me does the works."

John 14:28 "If you loved Me, you would rejoice because I said, 'I am going to the Father,' for My Father is greater than I."

John 17:21 "**that they all may be One**, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me." 17:22 And the Glory which You gave Me I have given them, **that they may be One just as We are One**: 17:23 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in One, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me."
