Read these: for they clearly reveal the true identity of the real Messiah of Israel!

Isaiah 9:6,7 [the Messiah!]

For unto us <u>a Child is born</u>, unto us <u>a Son is given</u>. And **the Government** shall be upon **His shoulder**. And His Name shall be called **Wonderful** (**Miracle**), **Counsellor**, <u>the Mighty God</u>, <u>the Everlasting Father</u>, <u>the Prince of Peace</u>. Of the increase of **His Government and Peace** there shall be <u>no end upon</u> the Throne of David, and over **His Kingdom**, to order it, and to establish it with Judgment and Justice, from henceforth and even forever. (Isaiah 16:5)

The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Micah 5:2, 4 [the Messiah!]

But you, **Bethlehem** Ephrathah, though you be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of you **shall He come forth to Me who is to be** <u>**Ruler</u> in Israel**; whose goings forth have been **from of old**, **from Everlasting**.</u>

And **He shall stand and feed in the Strength of the LORD**, in the **Majesty** of the name of the LORD **His God**; and **They shall Abide**.

For now **He shall be Great** to the ends of the earth.

Genesis 18:13, 14

And the LORD said to Abraham, "Why did Sarah laugh, saying, 'Shall I really bear a child when I am old?' **Is anything too hard for the LORD?** At the appointed time I will return to you, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son." (also see Jeremiah 32:17, 27)

Isaiah 7:14

[the Messiah!]

Therefore the LORD Himself shall give you <u>a sign</u>; Behold, <u>the virgin</u>

shall conceive, and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanu El!

(God is with us) [also see Genesis 3:15 and Psalm 132:11]

Zechariah 12:10 (also read verses 8 & 9 and Psalm 22:7-22) [the Messiah!]

And I (the LORD) will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of Grace and of Supplication, and

they shall look upon Me whom they have Pierced,

and they shall **mourn for Him**, as one mourns for **his only son**, and shall be in bitterness **for Him**, as one that is in bitterness for **his firstborn**.

Daniel 7:9, 13, 14

[the Messiah!]

I watched till **Thrones** were put in place, and **the Ancient of Days** was seated; His garment was white as snow, the hair of His head like pure wool...

I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like <u>the Son of Man</u> came with the Clouds of Heaven, and came to **the Ancient of Days**, and they brought Him near before Him. And **there was given Him Dominion**, and Glory, and a Kingdom, that <u>all peoples</u>, nations, and languages should serve <u>Him</u>. **His Dominion** is an everlasting Dominion, which shall not pass away, and **His Kingdom** that which shall not be destroyed!

Proverbs 30:4 Who has ascended up into Heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? **What is**

His name and what is His Son's name, if you can tell?

[the Messiah!]

Daniel 3:24, 25 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, and spoke, and said to his counsellors, "Did we not cast three men bound into the midst of the fire?" They answered and said to the king, "True, O king." He answered and said, "Oh, I see four men loose and walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and **the form of the fourth is like the Son of God!**" [the Messiah!]

Genesis 49:10 (also see Numbers 24:17)[the Messiah!]The Scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from betweenhis feet, until Shiloh come; and to Him shall be the gathering of the people.[In the days of Yeshua, the Scepter had departed, for Rome ruled Judah.]

Daniel 9:26 [the Crucified Messiah!]

And after sixty two weeks <u>Messiah shall be cut off</u>, but not for Himself! And the people of the prince that shall come (the Romans) shall destroy the city (Jerusalem) and the Temple... [This happened 2000 years ago!]

Psalm 110:1 (writer King David) **The LORD said to <u>my Lord</u> [the Messiah!]**, **'Sit at My right Hand**, until I make Your enemies Your footstool.' 110:4 ... You (Lord) are <u>Priest forever</u> by My word, Melchi Zedek (My King of Righteousness)!

Deuteronomy 18:15, 18, 19 [the Messiah!]

The LORD your God will raise up for you **a PROPHET** from the midst of you, of your brothers, like unto me (Moses); **Him you shall hear!** I will raise up **a Prophet** from among their brothers, like unto you (Moses), and I will put **My Words in His mouth**; and He shall speak to them **all that** I command Him. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not listen to My Words which He shall speak in My name, <u>I will require it of him</u>! Isaiah 59:16, 17, 18, 20 (see Isaiah 63:5,6 and Ezekiel 22:30) [Messiah!] And He (the LORD) saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor. Therefore <u>His own Arm brought Salvation for Him</u>; and His own Righteousness, it sustained Him. For <u>He put on</u> Righteousness as a breastplate, and a helmet of Salvation on His head; and <u>He put on</u> the garments of Vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke. According to their deeds, accordingly He will repay. Wrath to His enemies ... The Redeemer will come to Zion, and to those who turn from sin in Jacob ...

Psalm 40:7, 8, 9 Then I said, "**Behold**, <u>I come</u>! In the scroll of the Book <u>it is written of Me</u>! I delight to do Your will, O My God, and **Your Torah** is within My heart. I have proclaimed the Good News …" [the Messiah!]

Isaiah 52:10, 13-15[the Crucified Messiah!]The LORD has made bare His Holy Arm in the eyes of all the nations;
and all the ends of the earth shall see the Salvation of our God.Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently; He shall be exalted and extolled,
and be very High. Just as many were astonished at Him, so His visage was
marred more than any man, and His form more than the sons of men.
So shall He sprinkle many nations (with His Blood). Kings shall shut
their mouths at Him; for what had not been told them they shall see,
and what they had not heard they shall consider.

Isaiah 53:1, 4-6, 11 Who has believed our report? (also see Psalm 98:1-3) And to whom has <u>the Arm of the LORD</u> been revealed? [the Messiah!] Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows, yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But <u>He was wounded for our</u> transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities, the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; & with His stripes (Blood) we are Healed (Saved)! We all like sheep have gone astray, we have turned every one to his own way; and <u>the LORD has laid on Him</u> the iniquity of us all. ... My Righteous Servant shall justify many, for <u>He shall bear their iniquities</u>.

Psalm 22:1, 16 My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? They <u>pierced</u> (Blood) My hands and My feet! [the Crucified Messiah!]

Zechariah 9:9-11

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem. Behold, <u>your KING comes to you</u>; He is Just, and having Salvation; lowly, and riding on an ass, upon a colt, the foal of an ass.

He shall speak Peace to the nations, and His Dominion shall befrom sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth.As for you also, by the (Messiah's) Blood of your (New) CovenantI have sent forth your prisoners...[the Crucified Messiah!]

Genesis 3:15 [the Messiah!] (also see Psalm 132:11 and Isaiah 7:14) "And I will put enmity between you (Satan) and the woman (Eve), and between your seed and her Seed. He (the Messiah from her Seed) <u>shall bruise your head</u>, and you (Satan) shall bruise His heal (Blood)."

Leviticus 17:11 For the life of the flesh is in **the blood**: and I have given it to you upon the altar **to make atonement for your souls**; for it is **the Blood** that **makes Atonement for the soul**!

Jeremiah 31:31-34 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD,

that I will make <u>a New (Blood) Covenant</u> with the House of Israel and with the House of Judah, not according to the (blood) Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which <u>My (animal blood) Covenant they broke</u>, although I was a Husband to them, says the LORD. But this shall be the (New) Covenant that I will make with the House of Israel after those days, says the LORD. I will put <u>My Torah</u> in their inward parts, and <u>write it on their hearts</u>; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, "Know the LORD!"; for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For <u>I will forgive their iniquity</u>, <u>and their sin</u> <u>I will remember no more</u>! (by Messiah's Blood of the Eternal Covenant)

Ezekiel 36:25-28 (see also Ezekiel 11:19, 20; 16:60; 18:31, 32)

Then I will sprinkle <u>clean water</u> upon you, and you shall be clean. I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. I will also give you **a new heart**, and I will put **a new spirit** within you; and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you **a heart of flesh**. And <u>I will put My Spirit within you</u>, and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you shall keep My judgments, and do them. Then you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be My people, and I your God.

Psalm 118:22-26 The STONE which the builders rejected has become <u>the CORNERSTONE</u>! This is the LORD'S doing; it is marvellous in our eyes. This is the Day which the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. Save now, I pray, O LORD. O LORD, I pray, send prosperity now. **Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!** We have blessed You out of the House of the LORD. [the Messiah!] **Isaiah 8:14, 15** And **He shall be for a Sanctuary**; but for a **STONE of stumbling** and for **a Rock of offence** to both the Houses of Israel, as a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. And many among them shall stumble, and fall, and be broken, and be snared, and be taken. **[the Messiah!]**

Isaiah 28:16 (see also Daniel 2:34) **[the Risen Messiah!]** Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, 'Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation **<u>a STONE</u>**, **<u>a tried STONE</u>**, <u>a precious **CORNERSTONE**</u>, a sure foundation. He that believes shall not act hastily.' [stone = eben (Hebrew) father + son]

Daniel 2:34, 35 (44, 45) You watched until **a STONE** was cut out without hands, which **smote the image** upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and broke them to pieces. ... **the STONE** that smote the image became **a Great Mountain**, and filled the whole earth. [the Coming Messiah!]

Isaiah 42:1-4, 6, 7, 8 [the Messiah!]

Behold **My Servant**, whom I uphold; **My Chosen One**, in whom My Soul **Delights**. I have put **My Spirit** upon **Him**; He shall bring forth Justice to the nations. He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. ...He shall bring forth Justice... He shall not fail nor be discouraged, until He has established Justice in the earth; the isles shall wait for His Law.

I the LORD have called **You** in **Righteousness**, and will hold **Your Hand**, and **I will keep You**, and **give You as a (New) Covenant** to the people, as **a light to the Gentiles**, to open blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and those that sit in darkness from the prison house. I am the LORD, that is My name, and <u>My Glory I will not give to another</u>. (also Isaiah 48:11)

Isaiah 49:5-9 (see also Isaiah 11:10) [the Messiah!] "And now, says the LORD, who formed Me from the womb to be <u>His Servant</u>, to bring Jacob back to Him, so that Israel is gathered to Him, (for I shall be Glorious in the eyes of the LORD, and My God shall be My Strength!)

Indeed He says, 'It is a light thing that You should be <u>My Servant</u> to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved one of Israel. I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, <u>that You should be My Salvation</u> to the ends of the earth.'" Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, their Holy One, to Him whom man despises, to Him whom the nation abhors, to the Servant of rulers. Kings shall see and arise, princes also <u>shall worship</u>, because of the LORD who is Faithful, the Holy One of Israel; and He has chosen You!" Thus says the LORD, "In an acceptable Time I have heard You, and <u>in the Day of Salvation</u> I have helped You; I will preserve You and <u>give</u> <u>You as a (New) Covenant</u> to the people, to restore the earth, to cause them to inherit the desolate heritages; that You may say to the prisoners, 'Go forth'; to those who are in darkness, 'Show yourselves.'" **Zechariah 3:1, 6, 8, 9 [Messiah from the high priest family of Zadok]** And the Angel (Messenger) of the LORD admonished Yehoshua, saying, "Hear, O **Yehoshua**, <u>the high priest</u> (of the Zadokite family of priest Aaron), you and your companions who sit before you; for they are a wondrous sign. For, behold, I am bringing forth <u>My Servant, 'Tzemach' (the Branch</u>)!

For behold <u>the Stone</u> that I have laid before Yehoshua; upon **the Stone** are <u>seven eyes</u>. Behold, I will engrave its inscription, says the LORD of hosts, and <u>I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day</u>." (also Deut 32:43)

Zechariah 6:11,12,13 [Messiah from king David & Zadok high priest family] "Take silver and gold, and <u>make crowns</u>, and set them on the head of Yehoshua (Yeshua) the son of Yeho-Zadok, the high priest. Then speak to him, saying, "Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying, 'Behold <u>the Man whose name Tzemach</u> (the Branch)! From His place He shall branch out, <u>and He shall build</u> the Temple of the LORD! Yes, He shall build the Temple of the LORD! He shall bear the Glory, and <u>He shall sit and Rule on His Throne</u>; So <u>He shall be a Priest on His Throne</u>; and the counsel of Peace shall be between Them both.'" [The KING - PRIEST! The Messiah!]

Genesis 22:2, 8, 10, 11, 12-14, 15-18 (also see Genesis 18:1, 2, 10, 16-18, 22) Then He (God) said, "Take now **your son**, **your only son Isaac**, **whom you love**, and go to **the land of Moriah**, and offer him there as a burnt offering on <u>one</u> of the mountains of which I shall tell you." And Abraham said, **My son**,

God will provide <u>Himself the Lamb</u> for a burnt offering. And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son. And the Angel of the LORD called to him out of heaven... And He said, Do not lay your hand upon the lad, neither do anything to him, for now I know that you fear God, seeing that you have <u>not withheld your son from Me</u>, your only son. And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket <u>by his horns</u>. And Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering instead of his son. And Abraham called the name of that place 'Jehovah will provide'... Then the Angel of the LORD called to Abraham out of heaven the second time, and said, "By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son, that in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply your seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; your descendants shall possess the gate of your enemies. And in your Seed (the Messiah) <u>all the nations of the earth shall be blessed</u>, because you have obeyed My voice. [spoken on Mount Moriah: now Jerusalem Temple Mt area]

Psalm 2:6, 7, 12 Yet I have set My King upon My holy hill of Zion.
I will declare the decree, the LORD has said unto me, "You are <u>My Son</u>; today <u>I have begotten You</u>." Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and you perish from the way, when His Wrath is kindled but a little.
Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him (in the Son). [the Messiah!]

Genesis 14:18-20 [Melchi Zedek - the Preincarnate Messiah!] And Melchi Zedek, King of Salem, brought forth bread and wine; and He was <u>Priest of God Most High</u>. And He blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of God Most High, possessor of heaven and earth. And blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand. And he (Abram) gave Him (Melchi Zedek, my King of Righteousness) tithes of all.

Genesis 32:24, 28, 30 (also see Hosea 12:4 ... he struggled with the Angel) ... Jacob was left alone. And a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of the day. "Your name shall no longer be called Jacob but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with man and have overcome." And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel; for <u>I have seen GOD</u> face to face, and my life is preserved. [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

Exodus 23:20-23 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

See, I send **a Messenger** before you, to guard you in the way, and to bring you to the place which I have prepared. **Beware of Him**, and **obey His voice**, do not rebel against Him; for He will not forgive your rebellion, because

My Name is in Him! But if you indeed obey His voice,

and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies, and an adversary to your adversaries. For My Messenger shall go before you ...

Exodus 3:2-6 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

The Messenger of the LORD appeared unto him (Moses) in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush; and he looked, and behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the midst of the bush, and said, "Moses, Moses." And he said, "Here I am." And He said, "Do not draw near this place; take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground." Moreover He said, "I am GOD of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob."

Joshua 5:13-15 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood **a Man** opposite him with **His sword** drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him, and said to Him, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?" So He said, "**No**; but <u>as **Commander of the Army**</u> **of the LORD** I have now came." And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, **and worshiped**, and said to Him, "What says **my Lord** to His servant?" And **the Prince of the Army of the LORD** said to Joshua, "Take your sandal off your foot; for the place where you stand **is holy**." And Joshua did so.

Judges 13:3, 18, 20, 22 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

And **the Angel of the LORD** appeared to the woman, and said to her, "Behold you are barren and childless, but you shall conceive and bear a son." And **the Angel of the LORD** said to him, "Why do you ask Me what is <u>My name</u>, seeing that <u>it is **Wonderful**</u> (**Miracle**)?" For it happened as the flame went up toward heaven from the altar, that **the Angel of the LORD** <u>ascended in the flame</u> of the altar. When Manoah and his wife saw this, they fell on their faces to the ground. "... **we have seen God!**" [see Isaiah 9:6]

Jeremiah 23:5, 6 [Messiah (Tzemach) comes from the family of David!] Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I will raise to David a Tzemach (Branch) of Righteousness, and a KING shall Reign and Prosper, and shall execute Judgment and Justice in the earth. In His days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is His name whereby He shall be called, "The LORD Our Righteousness!"

Jeremiah 33:14-18, 24 [Messiah (Tzemach) from family of David & Aaron!] Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I will perform that good thing which I have promised to the House of Israel and to the House of Judah. In those days, and at that time, I will cause the Tzemach (Branch) of Righteousness to grow up unto David. And He shall execute Judgment and Righteousness in the land. In those days Judah shall be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely. And this is what shall be proclaimed in her (Jerusalem),

"The LORD Our Righteousness!" For thus says the LORD, "<u>David</u> shall <u>never lack a Man</u> to sit upon the Throne of the House of Israel. <u>Nor shall the Aaronic priests</u> from Levi <u>lack a Man before Me</u> to offer burnt offerings, and to kindle meat offerings, and <u>to do a Sacrifice for all days</u>!" God's Son would be born through these two families (verse 24) from the virgin. [This <u>Eternal Blood Sacrifice</u> is from the Messiah thru the family of Aaron!]

Zechariah 9:14, 15, 16 (see also Isaiah 27:13) [the Risen LORD & Messiah!] And the LORD (the Messiah) shall be seen over them, and His arrow shall go forth as the lightning; and <u>the LORD God shall blow the Shofar</u>, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south. The LORD of hosts shall defend them; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones... And the LORD their God shall save them in that Day as the flock of His people ...

Psalm 24:7-10 [the Risen Messiah is the KING of GLORY!] Lift up your heads, O you gates; and be lifted up, you Everlasting doors; and the KING of GLORY shall come in. Who is this KING of GLORY?

The LORD Strong and Mighty, the LORD Mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates; even lift them up, you everlasting doors; and **the KING of GLORY** shall come in. **Who is this KING of GLORY**? **The LORD of hosts, He is the KING of GLORY!** Selah.

Isaiah 16:5 [the Messiah, the Son of David & Aaron, is King & High Priest!]

In Mercy the Throne will be established, and One, shall sit on it in Truth <u>within the Tent of David</u>, Judging and seeking Justice, and hastening **Righteousness**. (Daniel 9:24 ... Everlasting Righteousness)

Daniel 10:5, 6, 14, 21 [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

Then I lifted up my eyes, and looked, and behold **one Man** clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz. His body also was like beryl, and **His face as the appearance of lightning**, and **His eyes as lamps of fire**, and His arms and His feet like in color to polished bronze, and **the Voice of His Words** like the Voice of a multitude. **[the Messiah!]**

'Now I have come to make you understand what will happen to your people in the latter days, for the vision refers to many days yet to come. But I will show you what is noted in **the Scripture of Truth.** And there is none that stands with Me in these things, but (Archangel) Michael, your prince.'

Zechariah 13:7-9 [the Crucified Messiah!]

Awake, O Sword, against **My Shepherd**, against **the Man** that is My Companion, says the LORD of hosts. <u>Strike the Shepherd</u>, and the sheep will be scattered; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones. And it shall come to pass in all the land, says the LORD, that two thirds shall be cut off and die; but one third in it shall be left. <u>I will bring **the one third** through the fire</u>, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will test them as gold is tested.

They shall call on My name, and I will answer them. I will say, 'This is My people'; and each one will say, 'The LORD is my God!'

Daniel 12:6, 7 And he said to **the Man** <u>clothed in linen</u>, who was above the waters of the river, "How long shall it be to the fulfillment of these wonders?" And I heard **the Man** <u>clothed in linen</u>, who was above the waters of the river, when He held up His right hand and His left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever, "that it shall be for a time, times, and a half (3 ¹/₂); and **when the power of the holy people** <u>has been completely shattered</u>, all these things shall be **finished**." (see Deuteronomy 32:39-41) [the Preincarnate Messiah!]

Psalm 89:20, 21, 26-29, 35, 36 (see also verses 3, 4, 34) **[the Messiah!]** I have found **My servant David**; with My holy oil I have anointed him. With whom My Hand shall be established; My Arm also shall strengthen him. ... He shall cry to Me, You are **my Father**, **my God**, and the rock of **my Salvation**. I will also make him **My firstborn**, **highest of the kings of the earth**. My Mercy I will keep for him forevermore, and My Covenant shall stand firm with him. **His Seed [the Messiah]** also I will make to endure **forever**; and **his Throne** as the days of heaven. Once I have sworn by My holiness; I will not lie to David. **His Seed shall endure forever**, and **his Throne** as the sun before Me; it shall be established **forever** like the moon. 1st Chronicles 17:10-15 (see also 2nd Samuel 7:5, 12-16) [the Messiah!]

Furthermore, I tell you (David) that the LORD will build you a house. And it shall come to pass, when your days for fulfilled and you must go to be with your fathers, that I will raise up **your Seed** after you, who will be from your sons; and I will establish His Kingdom. <u>He shall build Me a House</u>, and I will establish His Throne forever. I will be His Father, and He shall be **My Son**: and I will not take My Mercy away from Him, as I took it from him who was before you. And I will establish Him in My House and in My Kingdom forever; and <u>His Throne shall be established forever</u>! According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so Nathan spoke to king David. [the Messiah coming from king David's family!]

Isaiah 53:1-12 [Blood of Crucified Savior Messiah!]

Who has believed our report? And to whom is <u>the ARM of the LORD</u> revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of dry ground. He has no form nor comeliness, and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected of men; **a Man of sorrows**, and acquainted with grief, and we hid as it were our faces from Him. He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. <u>Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows</u>. Yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. <u>But He was wounded</u> for our transgressions, **He was bruised** for our iniquities. The chastisement of our peace was upon Him; **and with His Stripes we are Healed!**

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and **the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all**. He was oppressed, and **He was afflicted**, **yet He opened not His mouth**. He was brought as **a Lamb to the slaughter**, and as **a Sheep** before her shearers is dumb, so He opened not His mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who shall declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; **for the transgression of My people He was stricken**. And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When **You shall make His soul an offering for sin**. He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. He shall see the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied! By His knowledge

My Righteous Servant shall justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities. Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the Great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because **He has poured out His soul unto death**. And He was numbered with the transgressors. **He bore the sin of many**, and made intercession for the transgressors. **Isaiah 11:1, 2, 3, 4, 5, (10)** [the Messiah!] And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse (David's father), and a Branch shall grow out of his roots. And <u>the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him</u>; the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Might, the Spirit of Knowledge and the fear of the LORD. His delight is in the fear of the LORD. But with Righteousness He shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth. And He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and He shall slay the wicked with the breath of His lips. Righteousness shall be the belt of His loins, faithfulness the belt of His waist. (also see Revelation 5:6)

Isaiah 61:1, 2 [the Messiah!]

The Spirit of the Lord GOD <u>is upon Me</u>; because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the meek; He has sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; to proclaim **the acceptable Year** of the LORD, and **the Day of Vengeance (God's Wrath)** of our God; to comfort all that mourn...

Isaiah 63:8-10 [the Crucified Messiah!]

... He was their Saviour. In all their affliction <u>He was afflicted</u>, and <u>the Angel of His Presence saved them</u>. In <u>His Love</u> and in <u>His pity</u> He redeemed them; and He bare them, and carried them all the days of old. But they rebelled and grieved **His Holy Spirit**.

Genesis 1:26; Genesis 3:22; Genesis 11:7; Isaiah 6:8; Isaiah 48:16; 52:6,7; "Let 'Us' make Adam in '<u>Our' image</u>, after '<u>Our' likeness</u>. And let them have **Dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, and **over all the earth**, over every creeping thing" "Behold, **Adam** has become <u>like one of 'Us</u>', to know good and evil!" "Come, <u>let 'Us</u>' go down and <u>let 'Us</u>' confuse their language..."

"Whom shall **I send**, and **who will go <u>for 'Us</u>'?"** "And now <u>the LORD GOD</u> and <u>His Spirit</u> has <u>sent Me</u>!" "My people <u>shall know My name</u>; in that Day: <u>Salvation</u> (**Yeshuah**)!"

Psalm :84-6

What is man, that You are mindful of him? And the son of man (Adam), that You visit him? For You have made him <u>a little lower than Elohim</u>, and have crowned him with glory and honor. You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet ...

Hosea 1:10

Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered. And it shall come to pass in the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, there it shall be said to them, "You are sons of the Living God!"

Psalm 82:6

I said, "You are gods, and all of you sons of the Most High."

Isaiah 59:1, 2 Behold, **the LORD's Hand** is not too short, that it cannot save; neither His ear heavy, that it cannot hear. But **your iniquities** have separated you from your God, & **your sins** have hidden His face from you, so He will not hear.

Deuteronomy 24:16 (Ezekiel 18:4 ... The soul that sins <u>shall die</u>!) Fathers shall not be put to death for their children, nor shall children be put to death for their fathers. A person shall be put to death for his own sin!

"**Cursed** is the one who does not keep (all) the words of this Torah, to do them ... Then all the people shall say, '**Amen!**' "

Isaiah 64:6 (also see Ecclesiastes 7:20)

But **we are all like an unclean thing**, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags. We all fade as a leaf, and <u>our iniquities</u> like the wind, have taken us away.

Hosea 5:15 [the Risen Messiah!]

I will go and return to My place (Heaven), until they acknowledge **their sin**, and seek My face. <u>In their affliction **they will earnestly seek Me**</u>.

Daniel 12:2 (see also Hosea 13:14; Isaiah 26:19; Job 19:26; Psalm 49:15) And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth <u>shall Awake</u>, <u>some to Everlasting Life</u>, and some to shame and Everlasting contempt.

Numbers 23:19 (see also 1st Samuel 15:29)

God is not a man that He should lie; nor a son of man that He should repent. Has He said and will He not do it, or has He spoken and will He not make it good.

Jeremiah 31:3 (see also Deuteronomy 7:6-10, 12, 13) The LORD has appeared of old to me, saying, **Yes, I have Loved you** with an Everlasting Love; therefore with Lovingkindness I have drawn you.

These 70 Scriptures from the Tanakh prove that **Yeshua** is not only the true Messiah of Israel, but also of the whole world!

Psalm 138:2 For You have magnified Your Word above all Your name!

Psalm 119:89 Forever, O LORD, Your Word is settled in Heaven!

And the Word of our God shall stand forever!

12 Scriptures given in the Written Torah by God to Moses at Mount Sinai proved that <u>no divine Oral Torah</u> could have been given to Moses by God at Mount Sinai or anywhere else.

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Both Israeli Orthodox religious and secular Jews have been greatly deceived by forsaking **full attention to God's divine Written Words** given by God to Moses at Mount Sinai; for they have believed that God also gave to Moses **a divine Oral Law**, <u>which can't be proven</u> from any Scriptures. Orthodox religious Jews have placed a major focus on a supposed **divine Rabbical Talmud** and **Mishna Oral Torah**, <u>which did not come from God</u>!

This has become **very great idolatry** and has blinded religious Jews so that **they are not able to see Yeshua** <u>as the true Messiah</u> in these 70 Torah / Tanakh Messianic Scripture prophesies. Oral Torah <u>tradition</u> is definitely a very great deception. A divine Oral Torah **can easily be proven incorrect** by doing a thorough study from God's Written Word in both the Torah and in the Tanakh!

It would have been a lot more honest to just have said that their Oral Torah, or Talmud, is really handed down oral traditions: teachings, customs, opinions of the Jewish sages, leaders, scholars passed from mouth to mouth throughout the centuries. These were first written down around the late 200 C.E. by Rabbi Judah Hanasi as the Mishna. These were not something given by God to Moses at Mount Sinai as separate teachings from the written Word of God. It may also be fair to say that this was done to make sure that our Jewish people would not be able to see Yeshua as their true Messiah as prophesied in the Holy Scriptures, since the Oral Torah was written 200 years after Yeshua had come to earth, and also after He died as our Savior for all the sins of our Jewish people.

20 Scriptures: 12 Scriptures given by God written down by Moses, + 8 more in the Tanakh <u>forbid any oral Torah</u> by God's Written Words!

Exodus 24:3 So Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD and all the judgments. And all the people answered with one voice and said, "<u>All the words which the LORD has said we will do</u>!" 24:4 <u>And Moses wrote all the Words of the LORD</u> ...

Exodus 34:27 Then the LORD said to Moses, "**Write these Words**, for in accordance with **these Words I have made a Covenant with you and with Israel**." 34:28 So he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he neither ate bread nor drank water. And He wrote on the tablets the Words of the Covenant, **the Ten Commandments**.

Deuteronomy 4:2 "You shall <u>not add to the Word</u> which I command you, <u>nor take from it</u>, that you may keep the Commandments of the LORD your God which I command you."

Deuteronomy 8:2, 3 "And you shall remember that the LORD your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you and test you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His Commandments or not. So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every Word that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD!"

Deuteronomy 12:26 "Only the holy things which you have, and your vowed offerings, you shall take and go to the place which the LORD chooses. 12:27 And you shall offer your burnt offerings, the meat and the blood, on the altar of the LORD your God; and the blood of your sacrifices shall be poured out on the altar of the LORD your God, and you shall eat the meat. 12:28 * **Observe and obey <u>all these Words</u> which I command you, that it may go well with you and your children after you forever**, when you do what is good and right in the sight of the LORD your God." 12:32 (13:1, Hebrew) "Whatever I command you, be careful to observe it; **you shall not add to it nor take away from it**!"

Deuteronomy 17:18 "Also it shall be, when he (the king) sits on the throne of his kingdom, that **he shall write for himself <u>a copy of this</u> Torah in a book**, from the one before the priests, the Levites. 17:19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that <u>he may learn to fear the LORD his God</u> and be careful to observe all the words of this Torah and these statutes, 17:20 <u>that his heart may</u> not be lifted above his brethren, that he may not turn aside from the commandment to the right hand or to the left, and that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he and his children in the midst of Israel. **Deuteronomy 28:1** "Now it shall come to pass, if you diligently obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His <u>Commandments</u> which I command you today, that the LORD your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. 28:2 And <u>all these</u> <u>blessings shall come upon you and overtake you</u>, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God: 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if you do not obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe carefully all His Commandments and His statutes which I command you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you: 28:16 "Cursed shall you be in the city, and cursed shall you be in the country."

Deuteronomy 28:58 "If you do not carefully observe all the Words of this Torah <u>that are written in this Book</u>, that you may fear this glorious and awesome name, the LORD your GOD, 28:59 then the LORD will bring upon you and your descendants <u>extraordinary plagues</u>... <u>prolonged plagues</u>... prolonged sicknesses. 28:60 Moreover He will bring back on you all the <u>diseases of Egypt</u>, of which you were afraid, and they shall cling to you. 28:61 Also every sickness and every plague which is not written in this Book of the Torah, will the LORD bring upon you until you are destroyed."

Deuteronomy 29:29 "The secret things belong to the LORD our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us and to our children forever, **that we may do all the words of this Torah**."

Deuteronomy 30:8 "And you will again obey the voice of the LORD and do all His Commandments which I command you today. 30:9 The LORD your God will make you abound in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For the LORD will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers, 30:10 if you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep His Commandments and His statutes which are written in this Book of the Law, and if you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. 30:11 For this commandment which I command you today is not too mysterious for you, nor is it far off. 30:12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend into heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' 30:13 Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?' 30:14 But the Word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it! 30:15 See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil, 30:16 in that I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, and to keep His Commandments, His statutes, and His judgments, that you may

<u>live and multiply</u>; and the LORD your God will bless you in the land which you go to possess. 30:17 But if your heart turns away so that you do not hear, and are drawn away, <u>and worship other gods and serve them</u>, 30:18 I announce to you today that <u>you shall surely perish</u>; 30:19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that <u>I have set</u> before you **Life and death**, blessing and cursing; therefore **choose Life**, that both you and your descendants may live; 30:20 that you may love the LORD your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, **for He is your Life and the length of your days**; and that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them."

Deuteronomy 31:10 And Moses commanded them, saying, "<u>At the end of every seven years</u>, at the appointed time in the year of Release, at the Feast of Succoth, 31:11 when all Israel comes to appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses, you shall read this Torah before all Israel in their hearing. 31:12 Gather the people together, men and women and little ones, and the stranger who is within your gates, that they may hear and that they may learn to fear the LORD your God and carefully observe all the Words of this Torah, 31:13 and that their children, who have not known it, may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God as long as you live in the land which you cross the Jordan to possess."

Deuteronomy 31:24 So it was, when Moses had completed <u>writing</u> <u>the Words of this Torah in a Book</u>, when they were finished, 31:25 that Moses commanded the Levites, who bore the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD, saying, 31:26 "<u>Take this Book of the Torah</u>, and <u>put</u> <u>it beside the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD your God</u>, that it may be there as a witness against you; 31:27 for I know your rebellion and your stiff neck. If today, while I am yet alive with you, you have been rebellious against the LORD, then how much more after my death? 31:28 Gather to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, <u>that</u> <u>I may speak these Words in their hearing</u> and call heaven and earth to witness against them. 31:29 For I know that after my death you will become utterly corrupt, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you. And evil will befall you in the latter days, because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger through the work of your hands."

Deuteronomy 32:43 "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and render vengeance to His adversaries; <u>He will provide Atonement for His land and His people</u> (through the Messiah)." 32:44 So Moses came with Joshua the son

of Nun and spoke all the words of this song in the hearing of the people. 32:45 Moses finished speaking all these words to all Israel, 32:46 and he said to them, "Set your hearts on all the words which I testify among you today, which **you shall command your sons to be careful to obey all the Words of this Torah**. 32:47 For it is not a futile thing for you, because it is your life, and **by this Word** you shall prolong your days in the land which you cross over the Jordan to possess."

Eight more Places in Tanakh forbid Israel to leave the Written Word!

Joshua 1:1 After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, it came to pass that <u>the LORD spoke to Joshua</u> the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying, 1:2 "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them, the children of Israel. 1:8 <u>This Book of the Torah shall not</u> depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, then you will have good success."

Joshua 8:34 And afterward <u>he read all the words of the Torah</u>, the blessings and the cursings, <u>according to all that is written in the Book</u> <u>of the Torah</u>. 8:35 <u>There was not a word of all that Moses had</u> <u>commanded which Joshua did not read before all the assembly of Israel</u>, with the women, the little ones, and the strangers who were living among <u>them</u>. (Joshua read all these words of God to the people from <u>the written</u> <u>Book of the Torah of Moses</u>; for no oral Torah had existed then!)

Joshua 23:6 Therefore be very courageous <u>to keep and to do all</u> <u>that is written in the Book of the Torah of Moses</u>, lest you turn aside from it to the right hand or to the left ...

Proverbs 30:4-6 Who has ascended into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? <u>What is His</u> <u>name</u>, **and what is His Son's name**, if you know? Every Word of God is pure; He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him. <u>Do not add</u> <u>to His words</u>, lest He rebuke you, and you be found a liar!

Isaiah 59:21 "As for Me," says the LORD, "<u>this is My Covenant with them</u>. <u>My Spirit who is upon you</u>, and <u>My Words which I have put in your mouth</u>, <u>shall not depart from your mouth</u>, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants' descendants," says the LORD, "from this time and forevermore." An event in king David's life proved that there was no Oral Torah ...

1 Chronicles 15:13 "For because you did not do it the first time, the LORD our God broke out against us, <u>because we did not consult</u> <u>Him about the proper order</u>." 15:14 So the priests and the Levites sanctified themselves to bring up the Ark of the LORD God of Israel. 15:15 And the children of the Levites bore the Ark of God on their shoulders, by its poles, <u>as Moses had commanded according to</u> <u>the Word of the LORD</u>.

400 years later <u>a major historical discovery</u> happened in Jerusalem which again also <u>proved that there was no such thing as an **Oral Torah**!</u>

King Josiah lived from 640 BC to 610 BC (around 620 B.C.) The high priest Hilkiah found <u>the Book of the Torah</u> in the House of God, which king Josiah then had it read to all the people ... This also proved that the Aaronic priests then had no Oral Torah!

2 Kings 22:3 Now it came to pass, in the eighteenth year of King Josiah ... 22:8 Then Hilkiah the high priest said to Shaphan the scribe, "I have found the Book of the Torah in the house of the LORD." And Hilkiah gave the book to Shaphan, and he read it. 22:9 So Shaphan the scribe went to the king, bringing the king word, saying, "Your servants have gathered the money that was found in the House, and have delivered it into the hand of those who do the work, who oversee the House of the LORD." 22:10 Then Shaphan the scribe showed the king, saying, "Hilkiah the (high) priest has given me a book." And Shaphan read it before the king. 22:11 Now it happened, when the king heard the Words of the Book of the Torah, that he tore his clothes. 22:12 Then the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, Ahikam the son of Shaphan, Achbor the son of Michaiah, Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah a servant of the king, saying, 22:13 "Go, inquire of the LORD for me, for the people and for all Judah, concerning the Words of this Book that has been found; for great is the wrath of the LORD that is aroused against us, because our fathers have not obeyed the Words of this Book, to do according to all that is written concerning us." 2 Kings 23:1 Now the king (Josiah) sent them to gather all the elders of Judah and Jerusalem to him. 23:2 The king went up to the House of the LORD with all the men of Judah, and with him all the inhabitants of Jerusalem—the priests and the prophets and all the people, both small and great. And he read in their hearing all the Words of the Book of the Covenant which had been found in the House of the LORD. 23:3 Then the king stood by a pillar and made a covenant before the LORD, to follow the LORD and to keep His commandments and His testimonies and His statutes, with all his heart and all his soul, <u>to perform the Words</u> of this Covenant that were **written in this Book**. And all the people took a stand for the Covenant.

Nehemiah 8:1 Now all the people gathered together as one man in the open square that was in front of the Water Gate; and they told Ezra the scribe to bring <u>the Book of the Torah of Moses</u>, which the LORD had commanded Israel. 8:2 So Ezra the priest brought the Torah before the assembly of men and women and all who could hear with understanding <u>on the first day of the seventh month</u>.

[This was on the Fifth Feast of the LORD found in Leviticus 23:24, 25]

8:3 Then he read from it in the open square that was in front of the Water Gate from morning until midday, before the men and women and those who could understand; and the ears of all the people were attentive to the Book of the Torah. 8:5 And Ezra opened the Book in the sight of all the people, for he was standing above all the people; and when he opened it, all the people stood up. 8:6 And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. Then all the people answered, "Amen, Amen!" while lifting up their hands. And they bowed their heads and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground. 8:7 Also Yeshua (the priest) ... and the Levites, helped the people to understand the Torah; and the people stood in their place. 8:8 So they read distinctly from the Book, in the Torah of God; and they gave the sense, and helped them to understand the reading. 8:9 And Nehemiah, who was the governor, Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who taught the people said to all the people, "This day is holy to the LORD your God (the Fifth Feast of Leviticus 23:2, 25); do not mourn nor weep." For all the people wept, when they heard the Words of the Torah. 8:10 Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not sorrow, for the Joy of the LORD is your Strength."

In Nehemiah 8:1-10 we see <u>many important things</u>: <u>that there was no Oral</u> <u>Torah being used</u>, and that <u>the religious corruption of the Word of God given to</u> <u>Moses had not yet begun when priest Ezra returned from exile</u> <u>in Babylon</u>, for the 7th month was still called just that, <u>the 7th month</u>, without giving it a name (1 Kings 8:2, the 7th month was called Ethanim in days of Solomon), later it was <u>corrupted by the religious Orthodox Jews</u>, who called the <u>seventh month by the name Tishri, the Babylonian name for Babylon's 7th</u> <u>month</u>.

Also the first day of the seventh month was the date in Leviticus 23:23, 24, that God had announced for God's <u>fifth Feast of the LORD</u>. That is why Ezra and the other leaders could say that <u>this day was holy to the LORD</u>.

Later the Orthodox religious Jews changed <u>the name of this feast of the</u> <u>1st day of the 7th month</u> from the name God gave it in Leviticus 23:24, Zichron Teruah, and then in Numbers 29:1, Yom Teruah, to another name, <u>Rosh Ha Shanah</u>, Jewish New Years, named after the Babylonian New Years day held on the first day of their seventh month. And this brought great deception to both God's 7th month and also to God's holy Fifth Feast of Leviticus 23. This change was also in <u>direct violation of God's Word in Exodus</u> <u>12:2</u>, where God specifically said that the first day of the first month (Aviv), the month of Passover, would be Israel's New Years.

Exodus 12:1 Now the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, 12:2 "This month shall be <u>your beginning of months</u>; it shall be <u>the first month of the year to you</u>."

These 20 Scriptures prove <u>the written Torah</u> was all that Israel had, and also what Israel was commanded by God to obey! God never gave Moses a separate divine Oral Torah at Mount Sinai, or anywhere else!

This Writer's Conclusions

Many great deceptions <u>have come into Judaism</u> through the Orthodox religious Judaism. This great deception of their claim of <u>a divine Oral Torah</u> has opened up so many Jewish souls <u>to great idolatry</u> and much deception. The Oral Torah has blinded Israel and probably caused **their Greatest Sin:** <u>they</u> <u>are unable to see **their own God became their Savior and Messiah**</u>, who lived with them and died to save them from all of their sins. That their true Messiah, Yeshua, had been prophesied <u>in over 220 Scriptures</u> in the Hebrew Holy Scriptures, in both the Torah and in the Tanakh.

Father God loves the Orthodox religious Jews, and He wants them to know His Son Yeshua as their true Messiah and Savior who died for all their sins, in order to be able to give them into Eternal Life and Eternal Salvation.

Why did God give Israel a New Covenant?

It is of great importance to understand the many reasons why God, out of His great love and mercy for Israel and Judah, had first announced that He would be <u>making a New Covenant with Israel</u>. God had said this because so **many times the people of Israel had <u>broken God's Covenant</u>** which Israel had made with God at Mount Sinai. This was also because of the traditions of men, which many of the people held above the Commandments of God. Read Mark 7:9, He (Yeshua) said to them, "All too well you reject the Commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition."

Jeremiah 31:31 "Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make **a New Covenant** with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, 31:32 not according to the Covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My Covenant **which they broke** (made at Sinai), though I was a Master to them, says the LORD. 31:33 But this is the Covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My Torah in their minds, and write (My words) it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 31:34 No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

This New Covenant had to be <u>ratified with blood</u>, just as God's first Covenant given to Israel at Mount Sinai was also ratified with blood by Moses. See Exodus 24:6-8 <u>But whose blood would be used</u> to ratify this New Covenant, since this New Covenant was to be very different from the Covenant which God had made with Israel at Mount Sinai? For it had been announced ahead of time that not only would God's Torah <u>now be written</u> <u>internally</u>, putting this Torah on our mind and also writing it on our heart, <u>but</u> <u>also that our iniquities would now be forgiven</u>, <u>and that our sins would be</u> <u>remembered no more</u>.

Whose Blood would be used <u>for our Atonement</u>, since the Torah would be put inside of us, and all our sins would be forgiven? <u>Only sinless Blood</u>! This New Covenant would be <u>ratified by God</u> using **the sinless Blood of** <u>the Lamb of God</u>, **the only begotten Son of God**, **God's Son Yeshua**! This Truth was repeatedly prophesied throughout God's Holy Word!

Genessis 22:8 And Abraham said (to his son Isaac), "My son, God will provide for Himself <u>the Lamb for a burnt offering</u>!"

This atonement had also been announced in Deuteronomy 32:43, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and render vengeance to His adversaries; **He will provide** <u>Atonement</u> for His land and His people."

Leviticus 17:11 "For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul."

This is also found in one of the most powerful Old Testament Scriptures <u>that</u> is still totally missed. It is in **Jeremiah 33:18**. "Nor shall the priests, the

Levites, lack **a Man** <u>before Me</u> to offer burnt offerings, to kindle grain offerings, and to do <u>an animal blood sacrifice</u> for all days."

It shows that a Man from within the Aaronic priest family, specifically the family of the Zadokite high priests, the only family of Aaron that God allowed to come before God, and allowed to do <u>an animal blood sacrifice</u> before God, (See Ezekiel 44:10-16), does this sacrifice continually." The Hebrew says, 'sevah kol ha yamin', an animal blood sacrifice for all days!

What animal was prophesied as being sacrificed in Jeremiah 33:18? Here we see the Great High Priest of Heaven, Yeshua, Melchi Zedek (My King of Righteousness), the Son of Man, offering up Himself as **the Lamb of God**, the Lamb slain from before the foundation of the world. See Revelation 13:8

The Man is Yeshua, never an Aaronic priest since He had no earthly father. But Yeshua, since He was born from the two families of the virgin is always from the Zadokite high priest family of Aaron from Miriam's mother. She was from king David's family from her father and also the Zadokite high priest family from her mother. See Genesis 3:15; Psalm 132:11; Isaiah 7:13, 14;

Yeshua's sinless Blood was the price that God paid for the sins of all humanity; but also to purchase back the earth! God had prophesied about His Son being our Messiah and Savior in over 220 Messianic Scriptures prophesies in both the Torah and the Tanakh. God's Son would die on a tree, taking our place for all our sins and sins of mankind on earth. (Deuteronomy 21:22, 23)

Jeremiah 1:12 Then the LORD said to me, "You have seen well, for I am ready to perform My Word."

Jeremiah 23:29 "Is not <u>My Word like a fire</u>?" says the LORD, "<u>And like a hammer</u> that breaks the rock in pieces?"

Hebrews 4:12 For <u>the Word of God is living and powerful</u>, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 4:13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

Read the Words of God's Son, God's Righteous Servant. Especially read Isaiah 53:1-12; Isaiah 9:6,7; Isaiah 7:14; Jeremiah 33:14-24; Zechariah 12:10. This Truth about God's Son is found in dozens of other Scripture prophesies.

Listen to the Words of Yeshua about His Heavenly Father ...

John 8:31 Then Yeshua said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My Word, you are My disciples indeed. 8:32 And <u>you</u> <u>shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free</u>!" 8:34 Yeshua answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. 8:35 And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. 8:36 Therefore <u>if the Son makes you free</u>, you shall be free indeed!"

"I and My Father are One!" John 10:30

Matthew 11:27 "All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except My Father. Nor does anyone know My Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him."

John 8:29 "And He who sent Me is with Me. My Father has not left Me alone, **for I always do those things that please Him!**"

John 10:17 "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My Life that I may take it again. 10:18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have Power to lay it down, and I have Power to take it again. This Command I have received from My Father."

John 11:25 Yeshua said to her, "<u>I am the Resurrection and the Life</u>! He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. 11:26 And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"



John 8:24 "Therefore I said to you <u>that you will die in your sins</u>; for if you do not believe that I am He, <u>you will die in your sins</u>!"

John 14:6 "Yeshua said to him, "**I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life**. No one comes to My Father <u>except through Me</u>!"

John 17:3 "And this is Eternal Life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Yeshua the Messiah whom You have sent!"



70 Messianic Scripture Prophesies taken from the Torah and the Tanakh reveal that Messiah's true identity is Yeshua; that the Holy One of Israel is also the Promised Messiah of Israel! +

12 Scriptures in the Written Torah given by God to Moses at Mount Sinai + 8 more Scriptures in the rest of the Tanakh [20] proved that no divine Oral Torah was ever given by God to Moses at Mount Sinai, or anywhere else! For the Torah's written Words totally forbid the people of Israel from any divine Oral Torah!

Who is **this KING of GLORY**? **The LORD of hosts** is **the KING of GLORY!** Psalm 24:10

When You make His soul an offering for sin, **My Righteous Servant** shall justify many, for He shall bear their iniquities. Isaiah 53:4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11

And Abraham said, "My son, God will provide **Himself the Lamb** for a burnt offering." Genesis 22:8
